Midnight November 5. Deadline to submit titles and other information to the registrar.

11:00a.m. Thursday, November 7. Loading the panels and lights and plastic bins into a trailer. Some of you have signed up to help. Don't forget. More helpers are always welcome! We have hired two home schooled teens to help us with loading and unloading. The address of our storage shed is 706 Alfred Street (at Live Oak). It is behind Ruby Lee's Beauty Shop.

Noon Thursday, November 7. At St. Joseph's Halle on San Antonio Street. Workers meet here at noon to unload the trailer and to set up the panels and lights. Volunteers of all shapes and sizes are welcome! Some of the work is strenuous and some is not. Suzanne is bringing **pizza and cokes** for the workers! No meeting Thursday night.

8:30a.m. - 10:00a.m. Friday, November 8. Art Delivery to St. Joseph's Halle.

- Bring your updated biography, printed on white card stock (we kept the ones from last year, and we can reuse those). **If you do not have card stock or a printer**, please email your biography to mizbarb@hotmail.com and I will print it for you. Do not wait until Friday to do that.
- Fill out your panel cards with titles and prices and a little information about the painting. Do NOT fill in the number. The registrar does that! Insert the panel card in the crevice between the frame and the painting.
- Be sure to attach the slip of paper that identifies your painting to the wire on the back

10:00a.m. until we are done (noonish) Friday, November 8. Hanging the show. If you have never hung a show, you can help an experienced person. Sometimes it helps to have garden gloves to protect your hands (especially if you are adjusting lights) and a pair of pliers for the hooks. Vertically challenged people can bring a step stool.

4:30 – 8:00 Friday, November 8. Reception. Bring your appetizer. We are asking that you consider the venue, so be sure your item is easy to pick up and not drippy or too messy. You can use cupcake liners for individual items like bars or brownies. Skewers for olives and similar items. Bring your stuff on a platter or bowl, rather than in a plastic or Styrofoam to go box, please. Label any dishes with making tape on the bottom of the dish. It is helpful to make a little sign, such as "brownies with pecans" or "no nuts". Label shellfish containing foods like crab dip and identify gluten free items.

4:00 on Sunday November 10. All hands on deck. Take Down. Awards announced before 4 pm. Come early to claim your award or to celebrate with the ones who win!

Contact Nan Henke if you want to paint or sketch as a demo during the show on Saturday or Sunday. You will not be doing an instructional demo. You just paint and talk to interested patrons as they visit the exhibit. Bring a drop cloth.
