Show Your Art!

Hi, DK artists! It's time for 15 DK artists to display ONE painting each in the FTC lobby for the fall. As I

mentioned in the last newsletter, FTC will not be handling the unframed artwork, as a nudge to get their patrons to consider our framed art. So, save your small, unframed goodies for our own DK show in November.

Here are the parameters:

Your painting must be framed or have finished gallery-wrapped edges. FTC is hoping for fall or winter/Christmas themes or color schemes. No abstracts or heavy collage work, please. Your painting must be original work. No prints. Prices should be \$100 and up. Sizes should be 8 x 10 images and up.

Paintings will be accepted on **Tuesday**, **October 17 at FTC at 12:30pm**. Please be sure your hanging wire ends are wrapped and your painting is signed. Entry paperwork and display cards will be provided in the lobby when you arrive. **Pick up for any unsold paintings will be Tuesday, December 19 at 1 pm.**

FTC handles any sales and subtracts the 25% fee. They pay in December, after the show comes down.

The first 15 DK members who email me at <u>dlafferty@austin.rr.com</u> will be our participants for this show. That's the only way I can reasonably figure out who gets to show. Full disclosure, I usually allow myself to show an extra painting in exchange for doing the administrative planning and details.

The Cheri Christensen workshop held at the end of September was a huge success! We had 13 DK members participate in the 3-day workshop. Cheri did a 2-hour demonstration in which she produced a beautiful rooster painting done in

brush and palette knife. Participants in the workshop followed Cheri's painting process which began with choosing to paint from a still-life or a photograph. On day one, participants produced a painting of their subject using only black and white paint - the purpose was to show the importance of getting the values of the painting correct before moving on to

color. Once the black/white painting was completed,



participants used that value study as a guide to create a second painting in full color. Cheri coached everyone on how she achieves her beautiful back-lit highlights that make her subjects "glow" in the sun. (the secret is mixing cad

yellow deep and white and of course making sure that color mixture is correctly placed next to her neutrals that are in the shadows!!)

Cheri will be hosting another workshop in Fredericksburg in the spring of 2024. If anyone is interested, they can find more details on her website.
