Pecan Creek School is located at 3410 Pecan Creek Road in Gillespie County, in the U.S. state of Texas. It was consolidated with Fredericksburg Independent School District in 1955. The school was added to the National Register of Historic Places listings in Gillespie County, Texas on May 10, 2005. The Bernhard Friedrich house served as the first school in 1899. Land, materials and labor were donated in 1916 to relocate the structure. Originally a one-room schoolhouse, additional rooms and storage were added as needed. Included in the later additions were a stage and dance floor. The local historical club Friends of Gillespie County Country Schools has restored the building, including original desks and other furnishings. The building is now used as a community center.

St. Joseph's Halle Fall Market Vendor Rules and Regulations:

Fees: 9'x10' booths \$100 before Sept. 1, \$115 after Sept. 15

Set up time: Friday afternoon, Oct.13, 5:00-9:00 p.m. & Saturday morning, Oct.14, 7am-8:45 am.

Show hours are 9-4:00 pm. Please plan to be finished with your setup before 9:00.

Please do not pack up before 4:00. We always have late shoppers.

We are not allowed to prop the front doors open during the show. We can prop them during setup/breakdown. Please do not ask. This is NOT my rule. It is the rule set by the Halle.

Vendor Rules:

- No smoking on the premise.
- No pets allowed in vendor booths.
- No lit candles, bubbles, glitter, sand, hay bales or straw, smoke or fog machines, or helium balloons allowed inside the building.
- **Absolutely** no garage sale items shall be sold.
- No alcoholic beverages will be sold or consumed on the premise.
- No profanity or displays of pornography allowed.
- Table covering must reach the floor.
- Decorations, displays or any other materials may not be attached to the walls, doors, or fixtures in the building.
 Use tables, stands, or easels.
- All vendors are responsible for cleaning their space. There is a dumpster in the parking lot.
- Park in the parking lot, not on the grass or in the fire lane.
- Venders are responsible for collecting and paying current Texas Sales Tax of 8.25%. If you do not have a sales tax permit, visit http://www.window.state.tx.us/taxpermit. There is no charge for a permit.
