- Written effective Workplace Violence Prevention Plan and Response with active employee participation
- Coordinate implementation of the plan with other employers (if sharing same office space)
- Recordkeeping all hazard indentification, evaluation, and correction (5 years), training records (1 year), incidents and investigations (5 years) to be recorded in an Incident Log
- Training to be provided to all employees
- Implement strategies to avoid physical harm
