The Chancel Choir of our church has resumed weekly rehearsals after a much-needed summer break. Have you ever considered the function of the choir in the liturgy? Simply put, the choir serves to lead the assembly's song, a long Lutheran tradition. Martin Luther encouraged choirs to lead the assembly's song rather than dominate it.

The choir sings what the assembly sings and more. They work diligently to prepare and rehearse music that is too technically challenging for the assembly. The choir is made up of people who have had musical training as well as those who have not had formal training. They wear robes to cover their street clothes and to reinforce their presence as a group and match the liturgical paraments and vestments. Robes also help impart a sense of unified purpose to the choir.

Choir members commit to rehearsing regularly in order to be better prepared for the responsibility of leading the assembly's song. Did you know that they rehearse hymns and service music, as well as choral anthems? The choir serves as a small group within the larger Christian community, reinforcing the sense of family and fellowship among its members. The Chancel Choir works hard, but also has fun along the way.

We invite you to consider joining with us in praising God through music. Consider these words of Martin Luther – "Next to the Word of God, the noble art of music is the greatest treasure in the world."

Luke 18: 1-14

Then Jesus told them a <u>parable</u> about their need to pray always and not to lose <u>heart</u>. He said, "In a <u>certain</u> city there was a <u>judge</u> who neither feared God nor had respect for people. In that <u>city</u> there was a <u>widow</u> who kept coming to him and saying, 'Grant me justice <u>against</u> my <u>accuser</u>.' For a while he <u>refused</u>, but later he said to himself, 'Though I have no fear of God and no respect for <u>anyone</u>, yet because this widow keeps <u>bothering</u> me, I will grant her <u>justice</u>, so that she may not wear me out by <u>continually</u> coming.' " And the Lord said, "<u>Listen</u> to what the <u>unjust</u> judge says. And will not God grant justice to his chosen ones who cry to him day and night? Will he delay long in helping them? I tell you, he will quickly <u>grant</u> justice to them. And yet, when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?"

He also told this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were <u>righteous</u> and regarded others with <u>contempt</u>: "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a <u>Pharisee</u> and the other a tax <u>collector</u>. The Pharisee, standing by <u>himself</u>, was praying thus, 'God, I thank you that I am not like other people: <u>thieves</u>, rogues, <u>adulterers</u>, or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week; I give a tenth of all my income.' But the tax collector, <u>standing</u> far off, would not even lift up his eyes to heaven but was <u>beating</u> his breast and saying, 'God, be <u>merciful</u> to me, a <u>sinner!</u>' I tell you, this man went down to his home <u>justified</u> rather than the other, for all who exalt themselves will be humbled, but all who humble themselves will be exalted."
