Professional development options

Professional development opportunities can be tailored to each school and can be paired with in person consultation with an Education Consultant to support follow through of strategies learned in professional development sessions.

SINGLE DAY PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SESSIONS:

These sessions can be done virtually or in person, they can cover a wide range of topics including:

Inclusion strategies for students with autism

This session will develop a common understanding of autism using the core components of social communication and emotional regulation. Educators will build universal and individual strategies and supports to use in their classrooms to target all diverse learning needs.

Shifting from problem behaviour to emotional regulation

Problem behaviour in the classroom can be a major source of stress. This session will outline respectful and effective practices for reducing and replacing problem behavior. It will focus on proactive and "heat of the moment" strategies to build trusting relationships with students and promote emotional regulation in the classroom.
