Judging Categories

1. **Animals.*** Exactly proportional, any size.
2. **Animals Misc.*** Heads, Busts or Groups
3. **Aquatic.*** Realistic.
4. **Songbirds.**
5. **Birds of Prey.**
6. **Game Birds and Waterfowl.***
7. **Miscellaneous Realistic Birds**
8. **Human Figures.*** Realistic, full body, proportional.
9. **Bust.*** Realistic. Any human, shoulder up.
10. **Human Caricatures.**
11. **Animal Caricatures.**
12. **Caricature Group.** (human, animal or mixed).
13. **Bottlestoppers, Magnets, Toothpick Holders.**
14. **Stylized Carvings.** Not realistic - general or implied details.
15. **Chip Carving.**
16. **Relief Carving.** Shallow or Deep.
17. **Santa Claus.** Any Santa carving.
18. **Holiday Carvings** (includes all holiday carvings).
19. **Walking Sticks and Canes.**
20. **Ornaments.** (any holiday).
21. **Miniatures.**
22. **Religious, Mythical and Prehistoric.**
23. **Wood Burning.**
24. **Found Wood.** (includes cypress knees).
25. **Bark Carving.** (all bark carvings).
26. **Roughout.** (open category only. All other classes can use roughouts in any category).
27. **Utility Carving.** (spoons, letter-openers).
28. **Floral.** May be displayed in vase.
29. **Miscellaneous.** Any carving that does not fall into the before mentioned categories

** Must be carved in the round.*

Instructor Assisted Class

All instructor assisted carvings completed by novice and intermediate carvers will compete in this class. Money awarded for 3 places with 10 or more enteries.

Competition Rules

1. Entries must be carved by person entering competition.
2. Carvings must be wood but, glass eyes and metal feet are allowed.
3. Mailed or shipped carvings will not be accepted.
4. The show committee has the right to add, divide or delete categories as deemed necessary.
5. Entries are submitted at the sole discretion and sole risk of the owner. Security is provided, however; The Sevier County Senior Center, Smoky Mountain Woodcarvers Association and the shows sponsors are not responsible for the loss or damage of carvings.
6. Group carvings must be mounted on a single base.
7. Carvings entered in competition will remain in the competition room until the show is over at 4:00 on Sunday.
8. Judges decisions are final.
9. Smoky Mountain Woodcarvers Assoc. has final decision over any and all competition related questions.
10. Carvings entered in competition must have been completed in last 3 years.
11. Carvings such as Wood Spirits and Relief Carvings larger than 8"x 8" must have a stand.
12. Carvings completed in Zoom classes can be entered in all classes.
13. Novice and Intermediate carvers can enter roughouts in all categories. Open roughouts in only category 26.

Competition Classes

Novice: Anyone that carves at the beginner level and must not have won Best of Novice at our show. Instructor assisted projects must enter in instructor assisted class. Rough outs are allowed in all Novice categories.

Intermediate: Must not have won Best of Intermediate at our show. Instructor assisted, projects enter in instructor assisted class. Rough outs are allowed in all Intermediate categories.

Open: Anyone may enter. Instructor assisted carvings not allowed. Open carvers cannot enter in instructor assisted classes.

Choose Class & Category

Choose a Class (Novice, Intermediate, Instructor assisted or Open), then enter up to 5 entries per category or 3 entries per category if you used unlimited entry method. Show Chairman has final decision as to suitability.
