Boots must cover the ankle and have a small flat heel (1" high). Helmets can be rented for an additional fee. Shorts and running shoes are allowed for non-horse activities. Campers should bring their own lunch and a refillable water bottle.

Please remember that Wake Robin Farm is a NUT-FREE facility.
