SPRING BREAK CAMP 2021

Wake Robin Farm March Break Camp sessions run from 9:00am to 4:00pm. Arrangements can be made for earlier drop-off (8:30am) and later pickup (4:30pm) for an additional fee. Our March Break Camp caters to children 7-12 years of age.

Previous riding experience is not required.

Strict COVID-19 protocols are in place at Wake Robin Farm to ensure the safety of our client's and staff. Safety measures include the following:

- Registration will be limited to maintain small cohort groups.
- Each cohort group will have a dedicated counselor and participate in daily activities together
- All campers must provide a Self-Declaration form regarding health status 2 days prior to arriving for camp
- Touchless drop off and pick up - Parents are asked to remain in cars.
- Temperature checks at drop off
- Masks worn at all times (except while eating)
- Handwashing stations provided throughout the facility
- Regular handwashing reminders
- 6' social distancing wherever possible
- Designated group supplies for learning activities and crafts
- All tack, helmet and equipment cleaned in between riders
- 50% of activities to be held outside (weather permitting)
- Contact tracing
- Parent communications throughout the week as required
- COVID-19 safety plan in place in the event a camper or staff exhibits symptoms while at the farm

As we get closer to the Spring Break additional protocols may be implemented depending on the current COVID-19 health regulations.

Camp sessions are structured to accommodate riders of all levels. Campers will receive one formal riding lesson per day. Beginner riders will be taught, with emphasis on sound basics of safety, equitation and good horsemanship. For the intermediate/advanced rider, we offer a more extensive program which allows riders to continue developing their riding skills in order to meet higher goals. They will work in a safe and friendly environment with supervision at all times. Campers will also participate in crafts, games and horsemanship/stable management activities.

Campers must wear proper riding equipment and dress appropriately for the weather. Helmets, boots and long pants are mandatory while riding. Boots must cover the ankle and have a small flat heel (1" high). Helmets can be rented for \$10.00 per day or \$25 for the week. Warm footwear, layered clothing and gloves are recommended for both riding and non riding activities. Campers should bring their own lunch and snacks, a microwave is available in the lounge for campers to use.

Please remember that Wake Robin Farm is a NUT-FREE facility.
