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Safe Sleep Policy

In an effort to provide infants in our facility with a safe environment in which to grow and learn we have implemented policies and procedures to create a safe sleep environment.

Following the recommendations of the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), and Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) regulations for safe sleep environments to reduce the risk of sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS), our written policy is as follows.

- All infants under 12 months of age will always be placed on their backs in safety-approved cribs, with a firm tight-fitting mattress. The only exception is if a note from the infant's physician is provided indicating a medical reason for an alternative sleep position.
- Positioning devices will not be used. The only exception is if a note from the infant's physician is provided indicating a medical reason to do so.
- Soft materials such as pillows, quilts, comforters, sheepskins, stuffed toys, and loose bedding will not be placed in the infants sleep environment.
- A sleep sack is the only covering that may be used to cover the infant. A swaddle blanket may be used up to three months of age and may not be wrapped tighter than the infant's chest.
- Each infant will have their own crib. Infants will not share a crib with other infants.
- When infants can easily turn over from their backs to their stomachs, they shall be put down to sleep on their back but allowed to adopt whatever position they prefer for sleep.
- Sleeping infants will be supervised at all times.
- Supervised "tummy time" will be observed while infant is awake.
- Child care staff will be trained in safe sleep and SIDS risk reduction.
