

## **THE 3-STEP BIBLICAL INTERPRETATION & TEACHING FRAMEWORK**

### STEP 1 – ESTABLISH (FOUNDATION OF TRUTH)

Question: What has God already established as true?

- God's nature and character
- Identity statements (who God says we are)
- Truth stated before command or correction  
Rule: Identity before instruction.  
Purpose: Remove insecurity, confusion, and performance faith.

### STEP 2 – DISCERN (FILTER & TEST)

Question: What must be tested, weighed, or distinguished?

- Competing voices and assumptions

- Warnings, contrasts, “but” statements
- Drift, mixture, subtle deception  
Rule: Discernment is for protection, not superiority.  
Purpose: Spiritual clarity without fear or suspicion.

### STEP 3 – WALK (INTEGRATION & OBEDIENCE)

Question: How is this lived faithfully?

- Practical obedience rooted in love
- Faith expressed through real decisions
- Patterns of abiding, continuing, walking  
Rule: Truth not practiced eventually fades.  
Purpose: Move truth from mind → heart → habits.
