Singer Songwriter Brad Hutchinson from *Brad Hutchinson Project* is working to immerse the county in jam rock grooves. Inspired by jam band styles, Brad says that he plays music because “It’s where I’m happiest”, which is evident when you hear him play. You get a sense of joy and a feeling of celebration and appreciation that only this style of music can provide.

Locals may have seen him playing guitar and singing originals & covers at venues such as the Par & Grill in Caribou and The Downunder Sport Pub in Houlton and he is often accompanied by various talented musicians including piano player/vocalist Corey Hill from Houlton. Most recently, Brad is excited that he's continuing his musical jam endeavor by forming a new band he calls *Barefoot Brotherhood* which will feature tunes by the Grateful Dead and Phish.

"Music has always been a big part of my life." Born and raised in Hodgdon, Maine, Brad came from a very musical family. It was a common occurrence for them to play and sing together at family gatherings, and he was encouraged to learn to play instruments at a young age. He started out playing piano but recalls how his piano teacher once told his mom "to stop wasting her money because I didn't want to actually do the books. I just wanted to learn Jerry Lee Lewis and play that all day long". Regardless of this feedback, Brad continued learning and playing music throughout childhood and into his adult life. At first, in early adulthood playing guitar was more of a campfire experience with friends. However, around 18 years ago, he joined a band and his professional career took off from there.

Brad feels a sense of satisfaction to be able to offer the county with a different genre of music than often found. When he plays, he likes featuring upbeat jam band covers and invigorating acoustic-lectric originals and is excited to announce his new band, *Barefoot Brotherhood*, which will continue to support his feat of sharing this style of music with locals. *Barefoot Brotherhood* began when Brad and fellow local musician, James Matilla talked about starting a Grateful Dead cover band. The idea quickly evolved into a Grateful Dead & Phish cover band with a mission of providing listeners with a fun and uplifting musical experience. *Barefoot Brotherhood* is made up of Brad on Rhythm Guitar & Vocals, James Matilla on Base & Vocals, Corey Hill on Keyboard & Vocals, Steve Quist on Lead Guitar, and Christopher Pelletier on Drums. Their first gig is scheduled for April 13th at The Warehouse Bar & Grill in Caribou.

Over the years, Brad has continued to build a following of dedicated fans. He is always humbled and gratified to see how the more and more he plays, the more people in Aroostook County come out to enjoy this special type of music.
