## **TRAVIS CYR**

## Songwriter/Singer/Acoustic Folk & Roots Musician

Singer/songwriter Travis Cyr has been working as a professional musician in Maine for over 20 years and is the man behind the monumental music festival, Arootsakoostik, held in Thomas Park in Stockholm each year in July. Originally from Long Lake, Cyr is truly an unstoppable force in the music scene in Aroostook County and

beyond. Spending much of his time each month traveling throughout the state of Maine playing shows, Cyr feels "truly blessed to share music and art with people who appreciate it's value".

"Art is created every day of my life and has been since birth." Cyr recognizes that art is used in everything, from writing, building, performing, to loving, gardening, and more. He approaches life each day with this attitude and takes inspiration from everything and everybody and uses it to write his music. Known for singing and playing his acoustic guitar with heart, his love of life is evident in the folk roots music he composes and performs. His creative process is very organic. "I don't believe you can force things. You just have to be open and ready to receive it when it knocks". Cyr feels content knowing he is a hardworking, creative artist in Maine.

Having released 8 CDs of original music, Cyr has worked with a multitude of musicians throughout new England and has recorded full band rock arrangements, lo-fi solo acoustic "farm to table" songs, and everything in between. Cyr tells us that he'll be working on a new recording later this year in a new location with a new band. Aside from recording albums, Cyr is found each weekend playing at many locations throughout the state. In Aroostook County, you can often find him playing at Eureka Hall, in Stockholm, alongside other musicians from throughout New England that provide the county with live, original jams. He also regularly plays at Frist Mile Brewing Co. in Fort Kent, Copper's Lounge in Presque Isle, The Par & Grill in Caribou and more. \*See above for a full listing of gigs each month.

Arguably one of Cyr's largest contributions to the Aroostook County music scene has been the creation and organization of Arootsakoostic, a music festival featuring a diverse lineup of bands. Since 2006, Cyr has been able to utilize this event to promote and expose talented musicians while simultaneously raising money and awareness for local charities. Thomas Park in New Sweden boasts a picturesque natural amphitheater, which acts as a perfect spot to host the event. Although a bit of a drive for some in the county, depending on where you live, it's well worth the time spent in travel, and gives event goers a feel of being transported to an exciting new world tucked away in the natural beauty of Northern Maine, where music and community togetherness are celebrated. This year's festival is being held on July 6<sup>th</sup> from 12-8 PM and includes music by *Tricky Britches, The Rugged, Shirt Tail Kin, Dominic Lavoie*, Cyr himself accompanied by *The Good Guys,* and more. Cyr urges the community to "join us for what always turns out to be a great, fun filled day with a fantastic soundtrack, all for a great cause".

It's not hard to see why fans adore and celebrate the music created by this talented musician. He has an innate drive to create art that embodies the inspiration to be found in everyday life, as well as deliver fun, invigorating musical experiences to the communities of Aroostook County.
