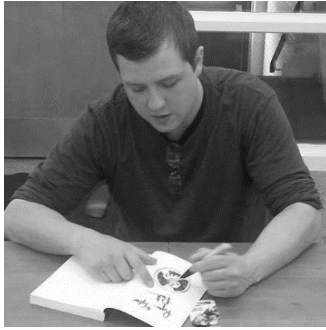

Ryan Palmer

Author & Visual Artist

Ryan Palmer, author, comic book writer, game designer, and illustrator, encourages artists in Aroostook County to never quit if you love what you're doing. Working both independently and collaboratively with other artists, Ryan has found that by using the internet to get a foothold "the world is not too large for us small town people" and has been able to find success in doing what he is passionate about.

Ryan is a lifelong Aroostook County resident and currently resides in Woodland. His artwork has been inspired by pop entertainment culture since he was 4 years old. Having always been drawn to a wide spectrum of gaming, movies, literature, comics, and more, he now realizes that his broad interests have allowed him to be a versatile writer, which he feels is one of his biggest strengths.

He began writing several years ago. In the beginning, he started with novel writing and then converted to comics. He studied comics within a collaborative storytelling medium and is now a self-published author. He has also begun writing tabletop gaming content and aspires to get into scripting animated film and digital gaming in the future. His process of creating begins with the writing of the layout and concept of his project. He then works with an art team to design the visual medium which puts a polish on the story that he has created. His current projects include *Hayward Saint's 8 Comic Heroes*, and the sci-fi comic book *Meteor Marlee & The Astronerds*. Often taking part in local events and providing workshops, Ryan feels lucky to have been able to share his creative vision with Northern Maine. He finds the most rewarding part about being actively involved in the community is the sharing of his process and advice with other creative types. "To inspire others with what inspires me is what entertainment is all about". Ryan reflects on the passion and creativity that is found in the people of Maine and encourages us to follow that passion. "Write and create what you love, so when you share it, that feeling will be contagious. Learn, ask questions, reach out to pros in your desired medium. Keep working and get better, while being vigilant in seeking and capitalizing on opportunity".

Ryan will be participating in the Presque Isle First Friday Downtown Art Walk happening on May 3rd. His work will be exhibited at Hardscrabble Solutions on Main St. from 6-9 PM during the art walk. For more
