- <u>Promotion Night is every second Wednesday of each month</u>. Please input this into your calendar schedule so you never miss it.
- There are no regular classes on this day. Instead please refer to the above times for this special day.
- Promotion Night counts towards attendance and as such all students are welcome to participate regardless of their rank status.
- Please arrive in a clean and complete uniform to this event. This is an important night for a lot of people and photos will be taken.
- Attendance is crucial to the possibility of you or your student ranking up. Please ensure that you or your student has participated in at least two classes a week totaling to eight attendance stripes for the Tiny Tigers and Little Dragons. If you are low on attendance, don't fret, we encourage makeups. Please speak to the front desk to schedule make up days or use our online scheduler found at BennatisMartialArts.com in our drop-down menu 'Student Resources'.
- Note that testing week occurs the week prior to Promotion Night. Ensure that you or your student have their basics and/or katas sharp to perform. Adequate attendance in the Dojo and home practice are *necessities*. A student will be eligible for either a patch or rank according to their instructors careful discernment. Attendance alone does not guarantee achievement. Do your best!
- Students who have been tested and officially passed by a Sensei will receive a Belt Promotion Form in which a parent or guardian will be required to fill out and fully complete at least three days before Promotion Night. The purpose of this form is to ascertain whether your student is progressing in their journey to Black Belt not only in the Dojo, but at home and school. These forms are extremely important to our program. Please take advantage of this form and be honest with us about your child's progress. We are a team and will address any concerns and will work diligently to improve them.
