"Eko-Zhivot" was founded in 2010 as a non-profit and non-governmental organization to work on conservation and improvement of the environment. We are in close collaboration with the local governments of cities Kavadarci, Negotino, Rosoman, Demir Kapija, and Gradsko.

We act as a regional eco center:

- In March 2014, we became members and participated in the establishment of Macedonia's eco-platform "Green Macedonia", a platform that will act for a cleaner and more ecological environment. Also, the main goal of this platform is to neutralize Macedonia's so-called "ecological hot spots", locations in Macedonia that are mainly affected by pollution.
- Since 2012 we have been members of the Ecologists' Movement of Macedonia (DEM) and assigned by them as a regional eco center and executive office.
- Since 2018 we are also acting as a branch of Food Bank Macedonia for the Tikvesh Region.
- In June 2021 we have become full members of the international network CEEweb for Biodiversity.
- In December 2021 we established the eco-educational center in the main city park in Kavadarci where we provide environmental education and activities for students and all the interested parties, including biodiversity info sessions for tourist visiting the region.




About Partner Organisation

Day 1:



The project activities were started by welcoming the participants. Partner organizations have presented their work, and each participant has given themselves experience with NGOs and the Erasmus+ program. Eko-Zhivot's youth volunteers organized some icebreakers to get to know each other, and later, we visited the weekend recreational venue Moklishte and 12 Vatasha children. This place has historical and ecological importance for the citizens of the Municipality of Kavadarci and the nearby cities, and they visit it regularly for recreation, to be closer to nature, and for outside educational activities.

Day 2:

A presentation was made on climate change, recycling and main environmental problems by one of the volunteers of Eko-Zhivot that has been the beginning of discussion among the participants.

We have also been creative and have learnt about recycling and upcycling, have made planting pots and decorative items from plastic bottles and other plastic items. To get familiar with the natural wonders around Kavadarci, we have visited Tikvesh Lake and the Strict Nature reserve Tikvesh. Tikvesh Lake is the largest artificial lake by the area, depth and length in our country, and second by the total quantity of water in it.



Day 3:

Our participants had the chance to visit one of Macedonia's greatest pearls – the city of Ohrid, which is protected by UNESCO. We have also visited the Hydrobiological Institute – Ohrid. The Institute is a public and governmental science–research and educational organization of national interest. It covers research subjects in limnology as in natural lakes, as well in reservoirs and rivers. The employees of the Institute have presented their work and their contribution for combating climate change and protecting the environment.





Day 4:

The last day of our activity was very active and started with visiting the Eco-Educative Center in the city park, managed by Eko-Zhivot Kavadarci, and presentation of the protected area in Kavadarci, our activities related to biodiversity and environmental protection. We have also visited the Wine Museum located next to the Eco-Educative Center.

At the invitation of the environmental department responsible person, we visited the Municipality of Kavadarci, where the participants heard about the environmental initiatives taken by the Municipality and the energy-saving projects implemented in the last three years.

We continued our activities in the NGO Info Center, where we informed our participants about Youthpass certificates and youth opportunities in the Erasmus+ program. Participants were informed about what they could do to share the outputs of the activities held during the activity and to deliver the project outputs to more people.

An educational workshop with young people from Kavadarci has been introduced by Eko-Zhivot's volunteers and together, they have prepared info boards about recycling.

In the evening we organised a traditional Macedonian dinner with traditional music and dishes. As the last event of the activity, youthpass certificates prepared for the participants were presented and thanked.

Outputs and Lessons Learnt

Participants were enabled to discover the Erasmus+ program and the opportunities it offers. By understanding the importance of the concept of ecological literacy, the participants were provided with new knowledge and skills in protecting the environment. While the participants' proficiency in understanding the information and news they read about the environment increased, their interest and curiosity about environmental issues also increased.

The knowledge, skills and sensitivities of the participants in the activity increased on environmentally friendly energy production, reusing products and goods with different characteristics, reducing use, recycling and upcycling. The motivation of the participants to take part in new projects and activities on these issues was also increased.

It was ensured that the representatives of the institutions involved in the project got to know each other better and mingled. The project schedule was further clarified by enabling institutions to better understand the activities to be carried out in their countries. Detailed information was given to the representatives of the institutions about the dissemination activities to be carried out during the project process and the visual tools of the project.
