ATTENDANCE

We adhere to the Miami-Dade School calendar, so you can be confident that your child's learning schedule is always current. Please note, we do not offer prorates or make-up classes for holidays; if Miami-Dade Schools are closed, so are we. However, we recognize the significance of maintaining your child's educational progress. That's why we strive to create an engaging learning environment that keeps students on track even during holiday breaks.

Tuition for our comprehensive 40-week dance program is due on the 1st of each month. The amount charged will remain consistent each month, regardless of holidays or the varying number of weeks in a month (4 or 5 weeks).

Regular attendance is crucial for improving and refining skills and talents. We encourage dancers to arrive 10 minutes early to class to warm up and change their shoes, as this routine helps maximize their learning experience.

We offer up to three makeup classes per year for absences due to illness, injury, family emergencies, or religious holidays. Please be aware that weather-related closures do not qualify for makeup classes. Please note, classes are assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis. Space is limited

Additionally, to foster discipline and focus, dancers are not permitted to leave class early or arrive late. This ensures they fully benefit from every class session.

REGISTRATION FEE

Class availability is on a first-come basis, so it is important to register as soon as possible. All participants must purchase a uniform for a fee of \$90 to secure your spot for the upcoming academic year without any additional fees. However, please note that starting this year, a \$50 registration fee will be charged upon new scholar year sign-up after May 15th. Act now and take advantage of this cost-saving option. PRE-BALLET & PRIMARY A, B, C

PRE-BALLET: Light Pink Uniform, socks, hair in 2 buns.

PRE-PRIMARY: Blue Uniform, socks, hair in 2 buns.

PRIMARY A: Purple Uniform, socks, hair in 2 buns.

PRIMARY B: White Uniform, socks, hair in 2 buns.

PRIMARY C: Periwinkle Uniform, socks, hair in 2 buns.

HIP-HOP: Black shirt, black shorts, dance Sneakers, hair in a ponytail.

CONTEMPORARY: Same uniform, pink tights, no shoes allowed.

MUSICAL THEATRE: Same uniform as ballet.

AMERICAN BALLET THEATRE NATIONAL TRAINING CURRICULUM

The ABT-National Training Curriculum (NTC) provides a comprehensive set of age-appropriate guidelines to ensure high-quality ballet training for students of all ages and skill levels. This curriculum incorporates best practices in sports psychology, child development, and nutrition.

ABT's teaching methods blend elements from the French, Italian, and Russian ballet schools. The curriculum is standardized across all ARB locations and training programs.

Director Myriam Ayala, an American Ballet Theatre Certified Teacher, will oversee the curriculum. All students are required to participate in mandatory exams starting from Primary A. The exam fees are as follows:

- Primary A: \$150

- Primary B: \$160

- Primary C: \$170

- Level 1: \$180

- Level 2: \$190

- Level 3: \$200

Each fee covers the exam itself, a certificate from the National Ballet School, and participation in a masterclass with the examiner. The exams are tentatively scheduled for the weekend of April 18th, so please set aside the entire weekend for this significant event in your child's dance journey. Charges will be applied automatically on January 1.



HAIR AND JEWELRY

Hair pulled back securely and neatly in a bun with bobby pins, hairnet, hairspray, and hairpiece depending on the level. No flyaways, no messy buns (bun should be pushed down to scalp) Absolutely no jewelry, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, anklets, or headbands are allowed! (only stud earrings, no hanging earrings)

Students without uniform or proper hair will be asked to sit out the class

TUITION POLICY

Tuition for our comprehensive 40-week dance program is due on the 1st of each month. The amount charged will remain consistent each month, regardless of holidays or the varying number of weeks in a month (4 or 5 weeks). *Tuition/fees and all payments are non-refundable, and non-transferable regardless of circumstance, either prior to, during or after the program. Please note: Ayala Royal Ballet reserves the right to cancel or modify classes/levels at any time

Please be aware that we require a minimum commitment of 3 months. If you wish to discontinue the automatic payment system, you must provide a written notice via email to school@ayalaroyalballet.com at least 30 days in advance. A penalty fee equivalent to one month's tuition will be applied to your account for early cancellation. If payment is not received by the 3rd of the month, a late fee of \$40 will be added to your account, and a past due invoice will be issued. Please note that missed classes are non-refundable; however, you are welcome to make up any missed class within the same month at the same or lower level.

DISCIPLINE & WAITING ROOM CONDUCT

All of us here at ARB are dedicated to helping our dancers grow and reach their full potential. Bullying or talking badly about teachers, staff, or other dancers is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated. This rule applies to both parents and students and any violations of this policy will result in expulsion. We strive to create a safe and supportive environment in order to foster our dancers' development and we take this rule very seriously. We hope all members of our school community can work together to provide a respectful and positive atmosphere for our dancers. If you need to speak to the teacher, please do so before or after class. If necessary, you may make an appointment with the Artistic Director to address any dilemma.

All parents are invited to wait outside the building for their children while classes are in session. To ensure the safety of all our students, please note that no student is permitted to leave the building without an adult. Furthermore, students must use the restroom before they enter the studio and only students are allowed in the studio. We ask that you do not interrupt the teacher while the class is in session.

Cell phones are not permitted to be used during class time. It is essential for both students and parents to understand that communication must be done through the ARB office. Direct contact with teachers through phone calls, emails, text messages, etc., is strictly prohibited. This policy is in place to ensure all communication is properly documented and regulated.
