The ABT- NTC consists of a comprehensive set of age-appropriate, outcome-based guidelines to provide the highest quality ballet training to dance students of all ages and skill levels. The curriculum is designed to include best practices in the fields of sports psychology, child/adolescent development, and nutrition.

National Training Curriculum

The teaching methods of ABT's National Training Curriculum incorporate elements of the French, Italian and Russian schools of training. The Curriculum is standard at all of ARB locations and training programs.

The curriculum will be overseen by Director <u>Myriam Ayala</u> an American Ballet Theatre Certified Teacher who has successfully completed the ABT Teacher Training Intensive in Primary through Level 5 of the ABT National Training Curriculum.

ATTENDANCE

We follow the Miami-Dade School calendar, so you can rest assured that your child's learning schedule will always be up to date. We do not offer prorates or make-up for holidays, so if the school is closed, we are too. However, we understand the importance of keeping up with the educational process, so we do our best to create a learning environment that keeps your child on track even during holidays.

We understand the importance of regular attendance and commitment to improve and polish skills and talents. To ensure you reach your greatest potential, we encourage dancers to arrive 10 minutes before class to warm up and change their shoes.

We allow up to three makeup classes per year for absences due to illness, injury, family emergency, or religious holidays. Unfortunately, weather-related closures do not qualify for makeup classes.

Dancers are not allowed to leave class early or arrive late.

Primary C: Peach Uniform Leotard, 1 bun

Hip-hop: Black shirt, black shorts Hip-hop Dance Sneakers Acrobatics: Acro leotard and shorts, hair in a ponytail, no tights. Contemporary: Same uniform, pink tights, no shoes allowed.

AMERICAN BALLET THEATRE PROGRAM: Age 8 and up

LEVEL 1 A & B: Turquoise Uniform Leotard

LEVEL 2 A & B: Plum Uniform Leotard

LEVEL 3 A & B: Wine Uniform Leotard

LEVEL 4 A & B: Navy Uniform Leotard

Pink tights, pink Ballet Shoes (Capezio Hanami Canvas)

Jazz: Tank top, black shorts, tan jazz shoes.

Acrobatics: Same uniform, hair in a ponytail, convertible tights.

Contemporary: Same uniform, pink tights, no shoes allowed.



Hair pulled back securely and neatly in a bun with bobby pins, hairnet, hairspray, and hairpiece depending on the level. No flyaways, no messy buns (bun should be pushed down to scalp) Absolutely no jewelry, earrings, necklaces, bracelets, anklets, or headbands are allowed! (only stud earrings, no hanging earrings)

Students without uniform or proper hair will be asked to sit out the class

TUITION

Tuition for our comprehensive 40-week dance program is due on the 1st of each month, and is charged automatically the same amount each month regardless of holidays or different lengths of months (meaning 5 or 4 weeks). We have a 3-month minimum contract If you wish to discontinue this autopay system you must send an email to school@ayalaroyalballet.com with a 30-day notice, and a penalty fee of 1 month's tuition will be charged to your account. If payment is not received by the 3rd of the month, a \$40 late fee will be added to your account and a past due invoice will be distributed. Unfortunately, missed classes cannot be refunded, but you can always make up the class on the same or lower level within the same month.

REGISTRATION FEE

Class availability is on a first-come basis, so it is important to register as soon as possible. All participants must purchase a uniform for a fee of \$90 to secure your spot for the upcoming academic year without any additional fees. However, please note that starting this year, a \$100 registration fee will be charged upon new scholar year sign-up after May 15th. Act now and take advantage of this cost-saving option. Enroll today and secure your place in our prestigious institution.

DISCIPLINE & WAITING ROOM CONDUCT

All of us here at ARB are dedicated to helping our dancers grow and reach their full potential. Bullying or talking badly about teachers, staff, or other dancers is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated. This rule applies to both parents and students and any violations of this policy will result in expulsion. We strive to create a safe and supportive environment in order to foster our dancers' development and we take this rule very seriously. We hope all members of our school community can work together to provide a respectful and positive atmosphere for our dancers. If you need to speak to the teacher, please do so before or after class. If necessary, you may make an appointment with the Artistic Director to address any dilemma.

All parents are invited to wait outside the building for their children while classes are in session. To ensure the safety of all our students, please note that no student is permitted to leave the building without an adult. Furthermore, students must use the restroom before they enter the studio and only students are allowed in the studio. We ask that you do not interrupt the teacher while the class is in session.

Cell phones are not permitted to be used during class time. It is essential for both students and parents to understand that communication must be done through the ARB office. Direct contact with teachers through phone calls, emails, text messages, etc., is strictly prohibited. This policy is in place to ensure all communication is properly documented and regulated.
