Barron and the Westside Union School District for hosting the meeting at Joe Walker Middle School.

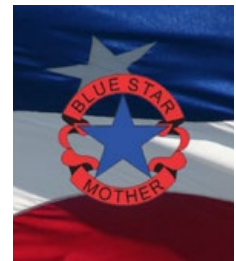
