Why does the State Bar certify legal specialists?

To encourage the maintenance and improvement of attorney competence in specialized fields of law.

What does it mean when an attorney is a certified specialist?

A certified specialist is more than just an attorney who practices in a particular area of law —they've gone above and beyond to demonstrate proficiency. A California attorney who is certified by the State Bar as an Admiralty & Maritime Law specialist must have:

- Passed a comprehensive written exam in Admiralty & Maritime Law;
- Demonstrated extensive and varied experience in Admiralty & Maritime Law;
- Completed additional and ongoing education requirements; and
- Been favorably evaluated by other attorneys and judges familiar with their work.

A certified specialist knows the overall picture and can discuss different strategies to help you choose the best one for your needs.

What can an Admiralty & Maritime Law certified specialist do for you?

- Review, negotiate, and draft charter parties, crew agreements, and other maritime agreements regarding vessel purchases, sales, construction and repairs.
- ✓ Advise vessel owners regarding a wide variety of maritime matters including liens, vessel documentation, and financing, and laws, including treaties, regarding the environment, safety, and navigation.
- Evaluate, prosecute, and defend claims for personal injury and death that occur on board vessels, in the water, on piers and docks, and in other shore side facilities.
- Represent parties in Coast Guard investigations and maritime casualties such as vessel collisions.
- ✓ Arrange for vessels to be arrested and released from arrest.

Given how specialized this field is, consulting a certified specialist is highly recommended.
