


Lesson 1: God's Faithfulness - Exploring how God remains faithful through all seasons of life.



Biblical Foundations of God's Faithfulness





**Old Testament: The Hebrew word for
faithfulness, emunah, conveys steadfastness
and reliability.**

**Deuteronomy 7:9 declares, “Know therefore that
the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who
keeps His covenant of loving devotion for a
thousand generations.”**

**This verse highlights God’s unwavering
commitment to His people.**

New Testament:

1 Corinthians 1:9, Paul writes, “God, who has called you into fellowship with His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.”

This passage affirms that God’s faithfulness is fulfilled through Christ.


