Biblical Foundations of God's Faithfulness



Old Testament: The Hebrew word for faithfulness, emunah, conveys steadfastness and reliability.

Deuteronomy 7:9 declares, “Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps His covenant of loving devotion for a thousand generations.”

This verse highlights God’s unwavering commitment to His people.

New Testament:

1 Corinthians 1:9, Paul writes, “God, who has called you into fellowship with His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.”

This passage affirms that God’s faithfulness is fulfilled through Christ.

- **Share Testimonies** – Encourage others by sharing how God has been faithful in your life.


