MORAL PRINCIPLES THAT GOVERN A PERSON'S BEHAVIOR OR THE CONDUCTING OF AN ACTIVITY ON OUR LIVES

ETHICS: CHRISTOLOGICAL

IN A CHRISTIAN ETHIC THE BASIS FOR GOOD OR BAD IS FOUND IN THE WILL OF GOD. IT IS A SYSTEMATIC STUDY OF THE LIFE EXEMPLIFIED AND TAUGHT BY JESUS

ETHICS FOUNDATION

THE ULTIMATE BASIS FOR CHRISTIAN ETHICS IS THE MORAL CHARACTER OF GOD

GOD IS OMNIPOTENCE: HE IS ALL POWERFULL (GEN 17:1/PS 115:3)

GOD IS OMNIPRESENCE: HE IS EVERYWHERE PRESENT (PS 139:7/12

GOD IS OMNISCIENCE: HE KNOWS EVERYTHING (PS 147:5/1 JOHN 3:20)

GOD IS ETERNAL (HEB 13:8)

GOD IS LOVE, SO HE COMMANDS US TO LOVE (1 JOHN 4:19). HE IS HOLY AND HE COMMANDS US TO BE HOLY (1 PETER 1:15) HE IS MERCIFUL, AND HE COMMANDS US TO BE MERCIFUL (LUKE 6:36) HE IS TRUTHFUL, AND HE COMMANDS US NOT TO BEAR FALSE WITNESS (TITUS 1:2; EXODUS 20:16)

GOD'S MORAL CHARACTER LIES IN THE FACT THAT HE HAS GIVEN US MORAL COMMANDS TO PROVIDE US WITH THE BASIS FOR A CHRISTIAN ANSWER TO THE QUESTION OF HOW WE CAN MOVE FROM IS STATEMENTS TO OUGHT STATEMENTS IN ETHICS

DAY 2: COCE FOUNDATION OF CHRISTIAN ETHICS

EXODUS CH 20: THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

MANY CHRISTIANS HAVE READ THE OLD TESTAMENT AND WONDERED HOW SHOULD WE UNDERSTAND THE DETAILED LAWS THAT GOD GAVE TO THE PEOPLE OF ISREAL UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF MOSES. THIS REQUIRES AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE HISTORY OF REDEMPTION

1 Peter 2:9

⁹ But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

THE MOSAIC COVENANT, WHICH BEGAN AT EXODUS 20, WAS TERMINATED WHEN CHRIST DIED. CHRISTIANS ARE NO LONGER DIRECTLY SUBJECT TO THE LAWS OF THE MOSAIC COVENANT BUT NOW LIVE INSTEAD UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW COVENANT. HOWEVER, THE OLD TESTAMENT IS STILL A VALUABLE SOURCE OF ETHICAL WISDOM, AND ETHICAL TEACHING IN LIGHT OF THE CHANGES BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE NEW COVENANT

Christ Fulfills the Law

¹⁷ "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. WHY CHRISTIAN ETHICS

ROMANS 7:7-25/ROMANS 3:23

- BECAUSE WE ARE AMBASSDORS OF JESUS CHRIST; WHOSE TEACHINGS ARE CENTERED ON BOTH THEOLOGY, ETHICS, AND MORALS.
- 2. BECAUSE ALL PEOPLE MAKE MORAL AND ETHICAL DECISIONS EVERY DAY
- 3. BECAUSE ETHICS PROVIDE THE STANDARD BY WHICH BELIEVERS CAN MEASURE THEIR SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT
- 4. BECAUSE IT TEACHES US HOW TO LIVE A LIFE THAT IS PLEASING TO GOD. HOW TO KNOW GOD'S WILL
- BECAUSE IT HELP'S GUIDE US INTO UNDERSTANDING THROUGH SCRIPTURE WHAT BEHAVIOR IS ACCEPTABLE AND WHAT IS NOT

- OUR ACTIONS MUST NOT BE SELFISH (1PETER 3:8/1 CORIN 10:24)
- 3. ACTIONS MUST BE DONE IN FAITH (HEB 11:6)
- 4. WE ARE TO SEEK RIGHTEOUSNESS (MATT 6:33)
- WE MUST BE COURAGEOUS (JOSHUA 1:7)

MORAL AND ETHICAL ISSUES WE FACE TODAY

RACIAL INJUSTICE; PREJUDICE AND DISCRIMINATION; EQUAL RIGHTS FOR MEN AND WOMEN; BIOMEDICAL ISSUES SUCH AS ORGAN TRANSPLANT, CLONING, ABORTION; CHRISTIAN INTERPETATION OF SCRIPTURE; HOMOSEXUALITY; LGBTQ LIFESTYLES; CAPTIAL PUNISHMENT; IMMIGRATION; CAPITALISM

CHRISTIAN ETHICS TEACHES US TO CONSIDER FOUR DIMENSIONS OF ANY ACTION, AND NINE POSSIBLE SOURCES OF INFORMATION

CHRISTIAN ETHICS IS NOT CONCERNED ONLY WITH OUR RIGHT AND WRONG ACTIONS. WE ARE COMPLEX PEOPLE AND LIFE ITSELF IS COMPLEX. THEREFORE, IN STUDYING CHRISTIAN ETHICS, GOD NOT WANTS US TO CONSIDER NOT ONLY

- 1. THE ACTION ITSELF BUT ALSO
- 2. A PERSON'S ATTITUDE ABOUT THE ACTION
- 3. THE PERSON MOTIVES FOR DOING THE ACTION
- 4. THE RESULTS OF THE ACTION

IN SEEKING TO KNOW GOD'S WILL SOMETIMES WE MUST MAKE A DECISION INSTANTLY, WITH NO TIME TO PONDER THE SITUATION (JOSEPH GEN 39:12). BUT AT OTHER TIMES, WE ARE ABLE TO PONDER A DECISION. WHEN WE HAVE MORE TIME TO PONDER A SITUATION, WE CAN CONSIDER AS MANY AS NINE POSSIBLE SOURCES OF INFORMATION

- 1. THE BIBLE
- 2. KNOWLEDGE OF THE FACTS OF THE SITUATION
- KNOWLEDGE OF OURSELVES
- 4. ADVICE FROM OTHERS
- CHANGED CIRCUMSTANCES
- OUR CONSCIENCES
- 7. OUR HEARTS
- 8. OUR HUMAN SPIRIT
- GUIDANCE FROM THE HOLY SPIRIT
- 10. PRAYER; WE NEED WISDOM FROM GOD IN ORDER TO EVALUATE THESE FACTORS RIGHTLY IN MAKING A DECISION

WE SHOULD NEVER THINK THAT GOD WANTS US TO CHOOSE A LESSER SIN. THAT IS NOT TAUGHT IN SCRIPTURE. LOOK AT THE LIFE OF JESUS (HEB 4:15) WHEN WE STRUGGLE REMEMBER (1 CORIN 10:13)

WILLFUL SIN BRINGS CONSEQUENCES TO OUR DAILY LIVES.
THE NEW TESTAMENT MENTIONS SEVERAL HARMFUL

CONSEQUENCES THAT COME FROM WILLFUL SIN IN THE LIFE OF A CHRISTIAN. THESE CONSEQUENCES INCLUDE A DISRUPTION OF OUR DAILY FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD (EPH 4:30/1 JOHN 3:21). THE AWARENESS OF GOD'S FATHERLY DISPLEASURE AND THE POSSIBLE EXPERIENCE OF HIS FATHERLY DISCIPLINE (1 CORIN 11:30/HEB 12:5-11/EPH 4:30/REV 3:19). AND A LOSS OF FRUITFULNESS IN OUR CHRISTIAN LIVES (JOHN 15:4-5)

EVEN AFTER ALL THIS WE STILL COME UP SHORT. BUT THERE IS HOPE

CHRISTIAN ETHICS TEACHES US HOW TO LIVE FOR THE GLORY OF GOD

THE GOAL OF ETHICS IS TO LEAD US TO A LIFE THAT GLORIFIES GOD (1 CORIN 10:31/COL 3:17)

SUCH A LIFE WILL HAVE

- 1. A CHARACTER THAT GLORIFIES GOD (PHIL 2:1-5)
- RESULTS THAT GLORIFY GOD. A LIFE THAT BEARS FRUIT FOR GOD'S KINGDOM (JOHN 15:8/16; COL 1:10/GAL 5:22-23)
- BEHAVIOR THAT GLORIFIES GOD. A LIFE OF OBEDIENCE TO GOD, LIVED IN A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD (GAL 2:20)

HOW IS IT MANEFEASTED: THROUGH A LIFE OF HUMILITY; FAITH; CHARITY; COURAGE; SELF-GOVERNMENT; VITURE; INDUSTRY; WISDOM
