



2026 Co-Ed Winter League Rules and Regulations



- There are limited spots available in our indoor golfing leagues, and therefore will be filled on a first come, first served basis. The League will begin January 5, 2026 and will run 12 weekly rounds until April 6, 2026, with an end-of-season match-up tournament running on April 25th 2026. Players must create a free GOLFZON account in order to participate.
- The cost to join the league is \$300.00+HST which does cover your weekly green fees, and a \$60.00 prize fund that is cash-only. All payments must be received before any rounds can be played.
- Each player will be responsible for playing the pre-selected 9 holes each week. The 9 holes must be completed in 30 minutes. If you complete your round before the time finishes you are more than welcome to continue to use the simulator. However, you are unable to bank this extra time to use on a future booking. Cancellations or no-shows made with less than 24 hours' notice will be required to pay a small fee.
- There is no set time of day or week that league players need to make their tee-time for. We are giving players the flexibility to book their tee-time whenever they are available during any given week. Players can therefore play ahead or behind within the given time blocks explained below.
- The season will be broken down into three blocks. Players must complete all weekly rounds by the last date of the block for them to count. You may book your rounds on a given last day, however we cannot guarantee there will be a bay available for you.

- Handicap Indexes will be created at the end of the season with the lowest 6 differentials of the total 12 rounds being played. These Indexes will then be used to calculate Course Handicaps for each week and player. This will increase fairness for all levels of experience, as the handicaps will be weighed against the real-world course ratings and an average of their ten lowest Handicap Differentials. If course ratings are unavailable then a 9-hole course rating of 30 and slope of 113 will be used.
- Prizes will be awarded at the end of the season and will be a mix of cash payouts and donated gifts from partnering businesses. There is the possibility to host an end-of-season tournament players are interested.
- Mulligans will be set to 0, and it is the responsibility of the players to ensure they understand where the O.B. is set for each course. Individual score cards will be given out upon registration and will be kept within the facility to aid in round tracking. Men will play from the White Tees and ladies from the Red Tees.
- Following any inappropriate behaviour, New Hamburg On Par Golf Staff may issue 2 verbal warnings, and reserves the right to remove any player from the league without a refund if changes are not made.
