

2025-26 Full Season League Rules and Regulations



- There are limited spots available in our indoor golfing leagues, and therefore will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Leagues will begin October 6th, 2025 and will run 28 weekly rounds until April 20th, 2026 with an end-of-season match-up tournament running on May 2nd 2026.
- The cost to join the league is \$700.00+HST (\$25.00/week x 28 weeks) with a \$60.00 registration fee that is cash-only. The cost covers your tee-time, and the registration fee will cover end of season prizes. The first half (\$350.00+HST) and registration must be paid in full before playing any rounds. The second half is due your first round back in 2026.
- Each player will be responsible for playing the pre-selected 9 holes each week. The 9 holes must be completed in 30 minutes. If you complete your round before the time finishes you are more than welcome to continue to use the simulator. However, you are unable to bank this extra time to use on a future booking. Cancelations or no-shows made with less than 24 hours' notice will be required to pay a small fee.
- There is no set time of day or week that league players need to make their tee-time for.
 We are giving players the flexibility to book their tee-time whenever they are available during any given week. Players can therefore play ahead or behind within the given time blocks explained below.
- The season will be broken down into four blocks. Players must complete all weekly rounds by the last date of the block for them to count. You may book your rounds on a given last day, however we cannot guarantee there will be a bay available for you.

- Handicap Indexes will be created at the end of the season with the lowest 10
 differentials of the last 20 rounds being counted. These Indexes will then be used to
 calculate Course Handicaps for each week and player. This will increase fairness for all
 levels of experience, as the handicaps will be weighed against the real-world course
 ratings and an average of their ten lowest Handicap Differentials.
- Flights will be created following the end of Block 1. The first flight will be scored completely based on Gross score, while the other flights will be scored by Handicap as well as Gross. Flights will be created and determined based on registration numbers.
- Prizes will be awarded at the end of the season and will be a mix of cash payouts and donated gifts from partnering businesses. More details on the end-of-season tournament will be released in the new year.
- Mulligans will be set to 0, and it is the responsibility of the players to ensure they
 understand where the O.B. is set for each course. Individual score cards will be given out
 upon registration and will be kept within the facility to aid in round tracking.
- Following any inappropriate behaviour, New Hamburg On Par Golf Staff may issue 2
 verbal warnings, and reserves the right to remove any player from the league without a
 refund if changes are not made.
