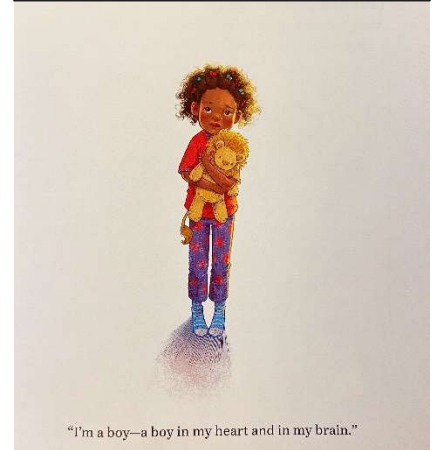
"Yeah, I know." George had been reading websites about transitioning since Scott had taught her how to clear the web browser history on Mom's computer. "But you need your parents' permission."

- He hired a new wonderful library director who cares about community standards, and the following changes have been made:
 - Conservative books are now being purchased with county funds, (previously only left leaning books would be purchased with county funds.)
 - Popular Christian children's books are now being placed on the shelves that would previously not have been allowed by administrators.
 - Children's books about gender transition, like those above, **have been moved away from young reader shelves** and placed in an area where adults can access them, along with Mein Kampf and The Communist Manifesto.
