

Lawn Care Calendar



SPRING

SEPTEMBER



- Apply pre-emergent herbicide to turf to prevent weeds
- Apply lawn fertiliser (low in nitrogen ie Seasol)
- Apply Trimmit[™] to trees and hedges to limit vertical growth and promote foliage and root growth

OCTOBER



- Apply lawn grub prevention
- Top up garden mulch
- Apply lawn grub control if required

NOVEMBER



- Dethatch lawn
- Top dress lawn
- Aerate/core lawn

SUMMER

DECEMBER



- Water lawn regularly if rainfall is low
- Apply lawn fertiliser
- Decrease mowing height (mow lawn shorter) remove only 1/3 leaf at a time

JANUARY



- Water lawn regularly if rainfall is low
- Check soil moisture content, add wetting agent if required

FEBRUARY



- Water lawn regularly if rainfall is low
- Apply lawn grub control if required
- Apply pre-emergent herbicide to turf to prevent weeds appearing

AUTUMN

MARCH



- Apply lawn grub preventative

APRIL



- Apply lawn fertiliser
- Increase mowing height (mow lawn higher) remove only 1/3 leaf at a time
- Aerate/core lawn to reduce compaction

MAY



- Top up garden mulch
- Apply ColourGuard[™], a pigment to maintain lawn colour over Winter (lasts 3-6 months)

WINTER

JUNE



- Apply lawn fertiliser (high in iron)
- Canopy trees (remove lower branches)
- Prune roses

JULY



- Check soil PH levels
- Clean gutters
- Reduce and shape hedges and trees

AUGUST



- Apply ColourGuard[™], a pigment to maintain lawn colour over Winter (lasts 3-6 months)
- Check soil PH
