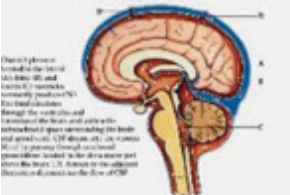

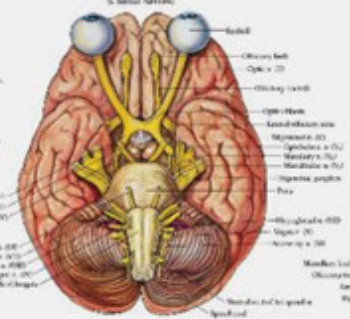
Coronal Section



Circulation of Cerebrospinal Fluid (CSF)



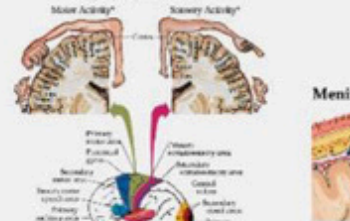

Somatotopic Organization of the Cerebrum



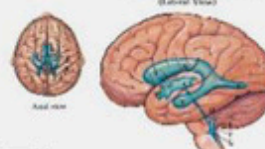

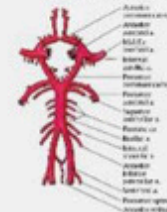

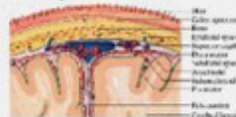

¹ The cerebrum is the largest part of the brain, accounting for about 85% of its weight. It is divided into two halves by a deep groove called the longitudinal fissure. Each half is further divided into four lobes: frontal, parietal, temporal, and occipital.
