MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, Florida is committed to ensuring the safety of all residents and visitors to our great state; and

WHEREAS, Florida is a top destination for motorcyclist tourism and more than one million drivers in Florida have a motorcycle endorsement on their driver license; and

WHEREAS, motorcycles and motor scooters are an economical means of transportation for young road users, including college students; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has a vision of zero traffic fatalities, "Target Zero," and recognizes the importance of reducing motorcycle fatalities, which accounted for nearly one-fifth of all traffic fatalities in 2019 in Florida; and

WHEREAS, compared to other motor vehicles, motorcycles offer minimal protection in the event of a crash and have unique steering and stability characteristics that require physical skill beyond that needed to operate a standard automobile; and

WHEREAS, motorcycles are often hidden in a vehicle's blind spot or missed in a quick look due to their smaller size, so motorcyclists and motorists must be vigilant in their efforts to share the road and ensure the safety of everyone; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has made comprehensive safety efforts to reduce motorcyclist fatalities and serious injuries by implementing the Florida Motorcycle Safety Coalition, educating motorcyclists, promoting motorist awareness of motorcycles, and enforcing traffic laws regarding risk-taking behaviors of riders; and

WHEREAS, to prevent injuries and deaths on Florida's roadways, motorcyclists and motorists must be vigilant in their efforts to share the road and ensure the safety of everyone.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ron DeSantis, Governor of the State of Florida, do hereby extend greetings and best wishes to all observing May 2021, as *Motorcycle Safety Awareness Month*.



PRESIDENTS REPORT: Doc – Pledge and Moment of Silence – For verification purpose: All reports go to the STATE office. It will then be dispersed to the proper people. All Chapters will be given Gun Tickets. Chapters will support ABATE of Florida, Inc. Chapters will donate the \$15 monthly for Website and News Service Report. It only goes for those 2 items. Just a reminder that all chapter money belongs to the State Corporation. State will also have events to raise money. It has been noticed that some Chapters spend more money than expected for hotel rooms and restaurants. Martha from Gulf Coast disputes the \$15 a month. “As a membership run organization, shouldn’t we have the right to decide if we want to spend the money.” Doc - We are a Corporation; Executive Board of Directors make decisions that are in the best interest for the Corporation. Peace River – Our chapter voted to pay yearly, is that accepted? Doc – Yes definitely. Our 40th year next month as ABATE of Florida, Inc. and we have membership because of the people of all these chapters.

VICE PRESIDENT’S REPORT: Darrin – YouTube – next videos will be of this meeting, and benefits of joining ABATE. Also, leadership seminar videos will be Legislative, and membership. Others to come. Being able to review information will be beneficial for new board members. Doc – a round of applause for the YouTube videos. Other States are asking us how to do it. Also, updates are available. MRF has requested info on meetings. Doc does not want info given to MRF. People can go to meetings and support local chapters.

SECRETARY’S REPORT: Lynn – Mention of accepting minutes from both December and February. December minutes were not displayed on Facebook due to an error. Entertain a Motion to accept the December minutes as presented on Facebook. Polk entertained the motion, Sue from Vintage 2nd. All in favor.

February’s minutes misstated hosting of February’s meeting. Correction noted by John from Forest – Forest chapter did not host this meeting. This is the correction - *Incorrectly stated “This year Forest will host April meeting the 2nd Saturday, April 10th.” Should state Forest chapter will help with the April meeting the 2nd Saturday, April 10th.” Motion to accept February minutes made by Heidi from Southwest, 2nd by Mike at Lighthouse. All in favor except 1 opposed.

TREASURER’S REPORT: Debbie – Entertained a motion for the Treasurer Report that are in your packets: Motion made by Lighthouse, 2nd by Forest. All reports are to be mailed to new State Office. Deb requested an email of the report to fulfill her monthly tax report.

SERGEANT-AT-ARMS REPORT: Marcus – Marcus, Sergeant of Arms, has family priority to deal with in Ohio. The Board will make a list of people to choose to finish his term. ABATE of FLORIDA, Inc. appreciates all the work Marcus has done and will look forward to his return.

STATE OFFICE: Brandy – Event insurance for day events is running different prices from \$150 and up. Group Ride insurance is starting at \$360 and may go up. Make sure I have the event insurance request, property release and the flyer. I can send you an invoice for the insurance if you want to pay by credit card, or you can mail in a check. If you pay by credit card, there will be a processing fee added to your amount. Poker Runs still require approved flyers and property releases. Once flyers are approved, they are not to be changed. If the event cancels or must move locations, you will need to contact the State Office. The flyer will need to be approved again and correction made to insurance. Updated flyer will be posted on the STATE website.

Board of Directors need to be updated as necessary and stay current. Martha from Gulf Coast verified that insurance is not required for standard Poker Runs. Yes, that was correct. Poker Runs are individual riders, not a group of riders. Heidi from Southwest asked if the flyer dictated insurance rates. Answer was no. Per Bill

Kelly’s question, Southern Most, what does dictate the price? Doc – insurance is determined by the insurance company payouts. Bridget, Forest, “Do we really need insurance if we don’t have anything?” Doc – Because of past events, chapters voted to continue with insurance. The Board will investigate possible “restructure”. Griz, Lake, explained the meaning listed on flyers – Kickstands Up, Pack Ride. 1st Bike out, last bike in, is a gypsy ride. Doc – 1-million-dollar lawsuit will dissolve the Corporation; it will then be hard to have credibility with law makers with a dissolved corporation.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT: Laurie – January: Highest Growth: Treasure Coast, Most New Members: Southeast February: Highest Growth: Polk, Most New Members: Forest
Griz – If a member is delinquent for a month, do they lose their benefits? Laurie – if I get their paperwork, they will be covered. A question was made by Martha from Gulf Coast: A) Does the full list of members include deceased Life Members? Laurie – Yes, they are members til the end of ABATE of Florida, Inc. B) Would it be possible to get information on their local AT Large members. Interested in starting a couple new chapters. Laurie – All members privacy is especially important. Information will not be given out. Doc – I will bring it before the Board about making a separate designation for deceased Life Members. Bridget, Forest, is it possible to get the list of endorsed motorcyclists from the State of Florida? Board – there is a cost for this information. It is estimated 1.5 million licensed in Florida. Doc will call on this info. It changes monthly. Griz – Lake, July 2019 there were 622,000 registered motorcycles paying the \$2.50.

PR/COMMUNICATIONS REPORT: Bill – State of Florida will have the Proclamation of May Motorcycle Safety Month in time.

WEBSITE REPORT/ Masterlink: Brandy – The ABATE STATE logo can not be changed, including color or shape. You can only change your local chapter logo. If you send the State your chapter, logo it will be added to the website/Masterlink. Please keep your board meeting info updated and submit the proper paperwork to keep MasterLink information correct. Pictures can be added to the Masterlink and Website if you send to the office.

Facebook (Gulf Coast): Carol - 412 like, 521 members, reached 8022 on Facebook. Like it, share it. Doc – Good job Carol.

SAFETY DIRECTOR REPORT: Victor (excused) Magnets are great. Both big and small. Heidi- Southwest, when people know they are magnets, they remove them from vehicles. Forest has asked for anyone not using their pull up Safety banners to please pass them on. Sue – Vintage, would love key chains to give out. Please limit handing out safety items to out of state people. To be used for Florida riders. Bridget – Forest, Black and white stickers are popular. First Aid kits as well. Children’s coloring books that Lake developed will be put on the State website for all to use. Steve – Treasure Coast, How about window decals? Griz – Lake, we cannot get magnets and such from the prison because they were hacked. Pilgrim will be checking on this. Also, all products need to have ABATE of Florida, Inc., on items. Ride Smart money comes from DOT.

PRODUCTS TRUSTEE REPORT: Shayne (Velcro) – Lifetime shirts sales. Will be checking on V necks for women. All lifetime shirts are gray.

LEGISLATIVE REPORT: Darrin – HB 2489 Safety Money has passed its first committee. Florida found money. Legislature is sweeping more Trust funds in general budget. Latest is the big educational fund being stripped. VRU bill, SB 278, is waiting for 1st committee and it is not on any agenda right now. HB 1643 Criminal Justice and Public Safety committee meetings are closed. Sessions ends April 30th. SloMo – Palm Beach, isn’t it a violation of sunshine law if not open to Public? No, they are using Zoom. Bridget – Forest, should we talk to local news about the \$2.50 belonging to Motorcyclists? “Can we get a STATE-Wide call out to get the News Channels to address “our money”?”. Doc has talked to several news outlets. And they mostly are not interested. Johnny Rose – Southeast, why can’t we get into schools? Griz – Lake, we are trying. Shared details on an accident involving a motorcycle death, possible no charges to car driver. Doc – Discussed several times where motorcyclists were killed, and car drivers not charged. Lack of people calling legislatures representatives show we do not care. John Banta – Daytona, No-name accident deaths make it hard to calculate information of who have been affected by motorcycle deaths. Let us stand up for those who cannot speak.

LOBBYIST: Doc – When going to the Capital, he had to show Vaccine Passport. Talked to Representative McClain pushing for amendment. Things have been cut, but the State of Florida found money. Doc is pushing for some of those funds. PSA is to be made. John Banta- Daytona, Repeal of No-Fault reports shows some good information. Talked about a bill concerning the “hold up of traffic”. Doc – we always talk to local cops and work with them.

Legal Counsel: Jerry T – It is encouraged that all sign a form of the COVID-19 sign in sheets.

NCOM UPDATE: Doc – June 19, 20 in Des Moines Iowa. 2022 will be in San Diego. Doc may not go this year but send a couple of Board members to discuss YouTube videos TALLAHASSEE: February 13th, 14th 2022


