It is taught in local schools & to civic organizations at no charge in the hope of reducing motorcycle accidents and deaths through education, not legislation.

In addition, we offer other items which is in your mail that you will receive. Explained the other items that are offered. Griz - Entertain a motion to accept American Income Life proposal. Forest made a motion to approve, Polk 2nd. All in Favor. Social Media – Any ABATE social media must be positive. Especially politicians. No negative response. Chapter Spending – Don't go and buy lunch with chapter funds. Use your money for real Chapter expenses. Thank you to Peace River Chapter. Brandy is not here. Dealing with personal issues.

**VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT:** Steve – Discuss committees. We are forming another committee for Safety Money/Legislative. We will be working on bills that matter. Will talk about Bylaw Committee later.

**LEGISLATIVE REPORT (BOB):** Heres a brief summary of our progress given by Rich. We must be more involved in items that keep motorcycles safe. Thank you for your calls concerning our recent loss.

Lana - (representing ABATE concerning the Safety Money 838) -On behalf of ABATE of Florida, Inc. I attended the Florida Motorcycle Safety Coalition at the Center for Urban Transportation Research (CURT) at the University of South Florida in Tampa on August 2nd and 3rd. Attendees were from all over the State representing FDOT, Ride Smart, Law Enforcement, Attorney's, Physicians, ABATE, ALR, LAMA and other groups. Many topics were covered from Motorcycle crashes, lane splitting, endorsement and rider training (basic rider 1 & 2 and advance rider coarse). Other Outreach efforts were on educating Judge's on laws pertaining to Motorcyclist. In the group discussion on SB838 Ray from FDHSMV, Edie from FDOT, Cesar from LAMA, John from ALR, Andy from Suncoast Brotherhood and myself (Lana) from ABATE. The bill is being review by FDOT and FHSMV attorneys at this time. The guideline of how we are to use the funding is written in the bill to be divided between 3 groups. ABATE should be working on what we can spend the funding on, mostly geared toward media, etc. (see SB838)

We will be having a Workshop in Orlando sponsored by Rich Newsome in September. Anyone wishing to participate there is a signup sheet by the BOD.

We have been invited to join Mike Dobbs, member of SMART, to set up our safety items during Biketoberfest at JP Cycle's from October 18th thru 21st, free of charge. Please let me know if you would like to join me in representing ABATE of Florida, Inc.

**LOBBYIST:** – Rich discussed the need for a full-time lobbyist. Explained the offer from Continental Strategies. Rich also discussed getting sponsors to defer the cost of a Lobbyist. He, himself, acquired 5 firms plus his firm to help offset the cost of a Lobbyist. Boneyard Chapter stated they could get one more. Guidelines and details need to be set up for these and any new sponsors. Daytona made a motion to hire Continental Strategies. 2nd Lake. Forest called for a vote. All in favor. We will hire Continental Strategies as our Lobbying firm.

**LEGAL COUNSEL:** (Rich) – Nothing legal to report.

**BYLAW COMMITTEE:** (Steve) Bylaw info sent to the President's and Vice Presidents of each chapter. Chapters need to discuss the presented changes and report back to Steve K or Lynn C by the end of September.

**NCOM UPDATE:** Griz hasn't received any info yet on the conference in June.

**STATE PARTY:** Roscoes? Nothing has been determined yet.






