



She became a member of Abate of Florida Inc. with a local chapter while my dad was still alive and we became more involved as well going to meetings and events. Abate of Florida Inc. Members soon became like family to us being their in our time of need when my dad passed they stood by us. My mom continued to do more events and we started going to help out as well. I leared alot over the years about life and family. I have see the good and the bad in people but I cant remember 1 time that an Abate of Florida Inc. or other biker was rude to us. I watched as grown men cried and did not care who seen them as they laid a Biker Friend to rest or gave someone a helping hand. All at the end of the day they stood proud and satisfied for their actions.



It's a lifesyle I am living my self now seeing all the positive actions that went on over the years. I remember getting up going help setting up for a ride where we Abate of Florida Inc. was doing a toy run to raise money for foster kids to have a Christmas. I remember our friend Dano playing Santa to over 100 kids who all got at lest 3 toys and other charilites even working with us to provide the kids dinners for the night. I remember mom cooking 4 turkeys and bringing them for the kids to have thanks giving dinner. This was a eye opening event for me to understand that there is kids that does not have anything some times placed in foster care with out any clothes being brought with them. Newborn Babies to almost 18 and so many. How about homeless, we all here about homeless and are quick to judge this is just a person who don't want to better their self, maybe even a veteran who has fallen on hard times and has no one able to help. Did you ever stop to thinnk about homeless kids in your own backyard. I have seen them listen to them tell their stories about how 1 or both of their parents was unable to care for them some due to drugs other do to being in jail others just don't have the money. So the kids try to fend for their self my mom got with a spokes person



or the local school where they also confirmed that this situation was real and these kids could go to the school before school started and shower and no child was denied food they would even make the kids a dinner to take home with them. Might not be nothing more than a sandwich but it was food. Abate of Florida Inc. Local chapter loaded a 20 foot trailer full of blankets clothes personal hygien items and toys for Christmas and took it to the school. where they was very grateful and did I mention this is why I am proud to belong to the biker community.

This shatters life's in the blink of an eye. Its not weather or not the person had on leathers its not weather or not the person was wearing safety gear there is no guarentee that will protect you. While people seem to thing that if you have on safety gear you will be ok no matter how much safety gear you have on coming to a sudden stop in 3 seconds as you was going the speed limit is not good. servival rate is very low. Think of it as u hitting a seni that has stopped to make a turn at the s speed limit even though you have your seat belt on and all the safety gear there is not guarentee you will live blunt force trama takes lives. No one should have to go threw life knowing they killed someone due to them being careless, Taking 10 extra seconds could save your life or a family members life. Once you hurt or killer a biker you affect the whole family think about it.



Someone Mom, Dad, Brother, Sister ,amd so on. Look at it this way you could have cost this family everything. If my mom was to get killed me and my sisters would not have been able to pay the bills we was minors. So know there is 3 kids with out a mom and dad and no way to supports ourself because someone made a bad decision. This years we have buried a lot of friends and family due to accidents . I dont want to be the next one buried do to someone deing distracted my live is just as valuable as anyone life in a car. I am a hard worker with a caring heart who happens to love motorcycles

So I guess is what I am really trying to say is the biker community caused me to become a very caring person and no one should be judge on what he or she drives weather

or not its a Harley or Honda we all have our own taste and when it comes down to it we just all want to return home safe that day to our families and just because I wear leather or I don't wear leather Just because of what I look like you never know who the person standing next to you might be. 


