



## MOTORCYCLE FREEDOM RIGHTS GATHERING 2022 ABATE of Florida, Inc.

Please Support HB2573 ABATE of Florida Motorcycle Safety and Education, sponsored by Rep. McClain. This bill will allocate \$300000 for ABATE's Motorcycle Safety & Awareness Program to reach out to the non-riding public. In July 2021, there were 638883 registered motorcycles in Florida, 36387 in Volusia County. Those owners paid an additional \$2.50 on their registrations to be used for motorcycle safety and awareness, originally for the Motorcycle Riders Training Program. The subsidies for the riders beginning course have stopped and, after legislation in session 2008, the funds are used at the discretion of DHSMV with the remaining being transferred to the DHSMV general fund. For a while the DHSMV was not doing much with motorcyclists' money. ABATE of Florida was able to get a \$499900 disbursement in 2007-2008; \$250000 in 2010-11, and \$250000 in 2010-11. There were strict auditing procedures and ABATE used State of Florida approved vendors. Thank you, Rep. Tom Leek and Rep. Elizabeth Fetterhoff, for your past support in committee. This is NOT free money. Stop removing this from the final budget.


HB743 Violations Against Vulnerable Road Users, sponsored by Rep. McClain SB1252 Traffic Offenses, sponsored by Sen. Baxley These bills create the Vulnerable Road User Act and would charge a misdemeanor against a person, who commits a moving violation that causes serious bodily injury to or death of a vulnerable road user. Any incarceration would be a house arrest. The House bill includes workers in the right of way and emergency services. In 2020 there were 169 bicyclist fatalities and 715 pedestrian fatalities. Deltona-Daytona-Ormond Beach metro area ranks second in the nation for dangerous places for pedestrians by the Smart Growth America Dangerous by Design 2019 report. We need something between a \$112 ticket for running a stop sign and vehicular manslaughter. In past sessions, these bills do not get heard in the first committee

Responsible riders do not condone dangerous behavior on the highway or disruption of traffic movement. Several bills are moving thru the legislative process. In 2021, social media organized Monster Truck Rally and Invade Daytona had law enforcement unprepared, overwhelmed and overworked. Local government officials indicated that existing statues are not a sufficient deterrent. SB1954 & HB1435 would double fines and allow impoundment. We need stronger deterrents against aggressive and inconsiderate driving that causes death or incapacitating injuries.

CS/SB876 & HB399 define stunt driving and street take overs. Any participation would be a misdemeanor and would be comparable to drag racing. If doing a burnout at a biker bar parking lot would be a 1<sup>st</sup> degree misdemeanor, how about causing the death of a vulnerable road user.






