

ABATE has developed & copyrighted “The Motorcycle Safety & Awareness Program”(MSAP). The program is presented to non-motorcyclists to educate them on how to safely share the road with motorcycles. It is taught in local schools & to civic organizations at no charge in the hope of reducing motorcycle accidents and deaths through educa-tion, not legislation.



He is trying to be at many meetings to go over the services. 4k Accident/Dismemberment for ABATE has paid 568,000 in claims since 2005. LEGISLATIVE REPORT: Darrin – Excused

LOBBYIST: Doc – No bills were heard this session. It is common for no bills to be heard during an election session. Many bills asking for money were turned down. Doc is getting an appointment with the CFO. There will be many changes in the Legislator. Many have termed out. With little “money” bills heard this time, Doc will be talking to the new Secretary of Transportation, and HSMV. He wants to find out where our money goes. The delegation will decide if we are doing the same bills or include Profiling. We want to make sure that The Clubs will support us. Some Club members do not want to be part of ABATE due to the testifying before the Committees. But standing up in Committees might be what is needed to get them passed. Southernmost asked if the “Ride Smart” program that same as our bills. Doc – Totally different items. Daytona – Should we be approaching law enforcement about endorsing our bills. Doc – Law Enforcement doesn’t like criminalizing everything. Our bills need some teeth, but too strong, it will turn away legislation. Peace River usually uses our bills to entice new members. Forest – Suggested to push Bills and sue for not being allowed to use the money from motorcyclist. The money in the fund is not being used for motorcycles. ABATE of Florida, Inc., has been audited and all its money goes to safety and education. Forest – would the lawsuit include back pay. Maybe they will pass our bill then. Treasure Coast – Will the bills be introduced again? Delegation will have to decide.

LEGAL COUNSEL: Jerry T- Jerry will be at the June meeting. He also has some items to go over with the delegation.

NCOM UPDATE: Doc – June 17th, 18th in Nashville. An award will be given to David Alan Coe at the ceremony.

TALLAHASSEE 2023: April 2nd, 3rd Dates were changed and voted on due to Easter. Forest made the motion, and Peace River seconded it. All in favor.





April 2022 Legislative Report

Hey Everyone,

Well, as you all know the regular legislative session ended pretty much status quo for motorcyclists. It is true that the legislators would not even give our Vulnerable Road Users bill or Safety money request bill a fighting chance to be heard in any committee. It is also true that no bills that would affect or restrict our rights and freedoms as motorcyclists even made it to the bill introduction process.

Our lobbyist, Doc, is most effective at getting any possible thought of an anti-motorcyclists bill from even getting enough traction to even make it to a possible bill. So again, we ended the session with all of our liberties and freedoms still intact.

Gov. DeSantis did call for a Special Session to deal with the maps for Congressional redistricting that happens every 10 years. Every time it is a big fight and lawsuits as one side or the other feels they didn't get everything they wanted. This year the vote went right along party lines and the final Congressional districts map were approved by both the House and Senate. As of this writing it is waiting for the Governor to sign it into law and then the lawsuits will start.

The legislators also took on the issue of the Disney Reedy Creek Improvement District that has been around since Disney started building in Florida. It basically gave Disney special rules to build and operate Walt Disney World. Special rules that do not apply to any other business in Florida.

The reason for the new legislative interest in the Reedy Creek Improvement District, stems from Disney's CEO deciding to publicly denounce and attack the Parental Rights in Education Bill which the uneducated called the "Don't Say Gay" Bill even though the bill does not even mention the word gay, but don't confuse them with the facts, their minds are made up.

The part that Disney and others had issue with was this; "*Classroom instruction by school personnel or third parties on sexual orientation or gender identity may not occur in kindergarten through grade 3 or in a manner that is not age appropriate or developmentally appropriate for students in accordance with state standards.*" So in normal reasoning, if you are against something with such a conviction that you are willing make such a strong and public stand. It must clearly mean that you are very much in favor of the action. Thus Disney and those that strongly oppose this bill are strongly in favor of schools giving instruction on sexual orientation or gender identity to kindergarten through grade 3 little kids.

The special session passed the bill that will do away with the "Special Improvement districts". This new law does not take effect until June 2023, so there is plenty of time for Disney and Florida to come together and possibly work out an agreement.

REPEAL OF THE MANDATORY HELMET LAW DID NOT JUST MAGICALLY HAPPEN

The helmet law in Florida was amended on 1 July 2000. This was a great day for motorcyclist in the State of Florida. We now had the choice to wear a helmet or not. The expression of "Let Those Who Ride Decide", came to its fruition. The new law allowed motorcyclists over the age of 21, who meet the insurance requirements, to ride without a helmet if they choose. In those 20 years since, the number of motorcycles registered in Florida has tripled. Also, the number of Floridians that have obtained their motorcycle endorsement has also tripled. Based on those numbers, about 2/3 of the state's motorcyclists have had the choice to ride without a helmet since getting their endorsement.

I wonder if any of them have thought about how this freedom to choose came about? Have you ever thought about what took place to gain our freedom? Most members of the Florida Legislature are not motorcyclists. It took a dedicated group of motorcycle enthusiasts nearly 20 years to educate our legislators and to gain their trust and support to amend the existing law.

ABATE of Florida, Inc. was founded in 1981 and is made up of a dedicated group of members who have stayed focused for over 40 years. They have fought to gain and maintain our rights as motorcyclists in our state. ABATE of Florida, Inc has a membership of over 5,000 men and women, who are dedicated to preserving our rights and our way of life. 




