RE: XCELBIO TECHNOLOGY

We have been using Xcelbio on our farm from the start of week 20 of the current flock (Hy-line Brown) and have found the following benefits in comparison to our last flock.

Initially we observed that our water feed lines started to be completely free of slime and bio-film to the extent that we discovered leaks at joints. The leaks resulted from the removal of the slimes that had been sealing the joints. This also eliminated the use of chemicals, previously applied to control slime formation.

The next observation was the flock moved above breed potential 2 weeks earlier than the previous flock, we also saw a reduction in feed cost of 6-8 percent, plus an increase in yield of 4 percent.

Other benefits have been shown in the reduced number of seconds, and the fact that we have minimal broken eggs in the shed to clean-up, and a reduction in sugar tops and much improved shell quality, further, we have also noticed that we have a reduced quantity of white eggs and that the eggs have a very consistent brown colouring.

With regard to the normal dosing protocols of Red Mite and de-worming we have found that the downtime after dosing is much shorter, minimising the effect of our daily yield.

The current yield at week 56 shows that we have an increase of 10,000 dozen to date, compared to the previous flock. We continue to maintain a weekly increase of 250 dozen. The reduction in downgrades has also added to the saleable yield.

The final, but not least point is that since applying Xcelbio the manure is much drier, making mucking out a much easier task.

We have a flock of very healthy happy birds, which will continue to profitably produce beyond the usually expected production period.
