We are thrilled to announce an exciting opportunity for our dancers.

ADULT TEAM SHOWCASE OPPORTUNITY - The Adult Team will be striving to participate in the World of Dance Hawaii on **October 5th, 2024**. This event will be more than just a competition; it will be a five-day trip dedicated to team building, training, and showcasing our choreography. Participation in this event is open to team members who are 18 and older.

TEEN TEAM COMPETITION OPPORTUNITY - Additionally, we are inviting our Teen Division to compete as a team at this prestigious event. To make this a reality, we need at least 9 competing members. This opportunity will also require a fundraiser to cover the associated fees with travel and stay. We will be providing more details on the fundraising plan and how you can support this effort in the coming weeks.

To prepare for these events, choreography will be integrated into the end of class times of required company classes. Parental Involvement:

Fundraising and Support:

Financial Information

Tuition Fees:

- Monthly tuition is due by the 10th of each month. Please ensure timely payment to avoid a late fee of \$15.
- Company members rate will be \$249 for mini and Jr divisions and \$299 for teen company Adult company rate is \$199 per month

Additional Costs:

- Costume Fees: \$300 annually

- Registration Fee: \$35 (due upon registration)

- Production Prop Fee: \$50

- Travel and Stay for Competition These costs will be outlined in detail as we approach the event dates. Fundraising efforts will help mitigate some of these expenses.

Scholarship Information:

We offer scholarships to deserving students who demonstrate exceptional commitment to classes and the IMD studio rules and etiquette. Scholarship recipients are expected to maintain high standards of attendance, effort, and participation in all studio activities, including fundraising events. Failure to make up classes will result in a decrease in scholarship assistance or complete removal of scholarship assistance. Space is limited so we ask that you respect our efforts by not taking advantage of our scholarship opportunity as you would be robbing our program and the deserving students on our wait list of families in need.

Health and Safety Protocols

We prioritize the health and safety of our dancers. Please ensure that your dancer follows these protocols:

- Wellness Checks: Perform daily wellness checks before attending classes.
- Hygiene Practices: Encourage regular hand washing and the use of hand sanitizers.
- Injury Prevention: Utilize recovery tools such as Epsom salts, which will be available at the studio.
