Scholarship Rules & Procedures

1. The applicant must have an OCAAO current regular membership **AND** have paid their membership dues in the previous year.
2. Members must be employed within Oakland County and have duties related to property tax assessment administration.
3. Scholarship funds may be used for all STC approved courses in assessment related fields or the MAA Annual Conference.
4. In addition to tuition and fees, funds may be used for related meals, lodging, and gas. **RECEIPTS REQUIRED.** Total reimbursement is not to exceed \$200.
5. The course must be completed, with all related testing passed prior to June 30th of the subsequent year.
6. OCAAO Scholarships are limited to one course per applicant. Scholarship recipients will not be eligible for consideration within the following three (3) years.
