






We also offer consulting and mentoring for individuals and organisations that connect with our social objectives – i.e. making our services available to people irrespective of their ability to pay.

Social outputs - financial value

We have donated £15k to the three main charities, and also a further £900 through CAF to various charities.

The equivalent of 13 days free mentoring and consulting services for a variety of organisations:

- A primary school (Hookstone Chase Community Primary School)
- A Leeds charity dealing with disadvantaged young people (Renew Leeds)
- An international peace organisation (ORG)
