JUST A DIRECT ORDER: SGT. HENDERSON, SGT. P. JOHNSON, SGT. PERELLI AND LT. MALLOY. THIS GRIEVANCE IS FOR THE BLATANT RETALIATION AND INHUMANE TREATMENT (PD.03.03.130) ON THE ABOVE STAFF AS WELL AS WARDEN J. HOWARD...

ON THE ABOVE DATE AT APPROX 8:20am, I HAD A CALLOUT TO GO TO THE WESTSIDE CONTROL CENTER FOR A CONFERENCE CALL. MY CALL ENDED AT AROUND 8:55am. UPON TRYING TO GET MY PASS SIGNED TO RETURN TO MY UNIT, MR. HENDERSON MADE MY AIDE LEAVE AND IN AN AGGRESSIVE TONE, GAVE ME DIRECT ORDER TO GO SIT IN A WAITING ROOM. HE MADE ME FEEL AS IF I HAD DONE SOMETHING WRONG. I THEN ASKED WHY WAS I BEING MADE/FORCED TO STAY THERE? HE SAID SIT DOWN. THE POLICY (PD.03.03.130 "INHUMANE TREATMENT" WAS VIOLATED WHILE I WAS DENIED FOOD, MY MUCH NEEDED MEDICATION, NO CLEAN WATER, NOR WAS I AFFORDED THE RIGHT TO SEND OUT MY LEGAL MAIL! THIS IS AND WAS A CLEAR ACT OF "RETALIATION" (PD.03.03.130) BECAUSE I WAS ONLY BEING FORCED TO STAY BECAUSE THERE WAS AN INSPECTION GOING ON BY MY ATTORNEY AND THEY DIDNT WANT ME TO SAY ANYTHING TO HIM. I WAS TO BEEN HIDDEN TO BE SILENT. I STAYED IN THAT WAITING ROOM FOR NEARLY (4) hrs, UNTIL MY ATTORNEY CAME AND THEN LEFT. I HAD ALSO ASKED SGT. JOHNSON WHY WAS I THERE AND COULDN'T LEAVE AND SHE ACTED AS IF THERE WAS SOMEONE THERE TO SPEAK TO ME WHEN SHE KNEW THAT THAT WAS FALSE. LT. MALLOY WAS AS LOST AS I WAS AND SHE ASKED THE ABOVE STAFF WHY WAS I THERE? SHE WAS THEN BRIEFED, AND TOLD ME TO SIT DOWN AS WELL. THIS RETALIATION HAS BEEN GOING ON FOR A LONG WHILE NOW AND IT NEEDS TO STOP! THIS ALL COMES AT THE EXPENSE OF MY HEALTH. I AM ON SERIOUS MEDICATIONS TO FIGHT THE MANY DIFFERENT DEADLY BACTERIAS IN MY BLOOD DUE TO MDOC NEGLIGENCE. MISSING DOSES COULD POTENTIALLY BE FATAL FOR ME!!!!

**COMPLAINT SUMMARY:**  
Prisoner Clark #435064 stated she was forced to sit at the control center for nearly four hours and was denied access to medication lines, clean drinking water, the ability to send out legal mail, and a food tray. She stated she felt this was in retaliation over her having an active lawsuit against the Michigan Department of Corrections.

**INVESTIGATION SUMMARY:**  
I interviewed the prisoner who stated she feels the same way and nothing new was needed to be added. I interviewed Ofc. Henderson, Sgt. P. Johnson, and Lt. Malloy who stated she had access to a drinking fountain in the control center hallway and she was given a food tray. I Emailed AA Horton who stated he did tell the control center to hold prisoner Clark to speak with her attorney. He stated he was not sure how long the attorney wanted to have access to the prisoner. He stated once he was aware she had spoken to the attorney and was still at the control center he advised the control center she could return to her unit. Legal mail is available to be sent out if the PC is on grounds, and they don't leave until 330pm. Medication lines was called before the prisoner was sent to control center and after she departed, she should have had access to med lines. The prisoner stated she felt she was being retaliated against however this appears to be a communication conflict between MDOC and the prisoner's attorney on how long the prisoner was needed to be accessed.

THE RESPONSE I RECIEVED IS UNSATISFACTORY AND CONTRARY TO THE EVIDENCE AND SO AM CONTINUING WITH THIS GRIEVENCE #2202053503F THAT WAS DENIED AT STEP ONE AND NOW AT STEP TWO. WITHOUT BEING THOROUGHLY INVESTIGATED AS WELL. ORIGINALLY THE REVILWER SGT. SMITH BEGAN READING MY GRIEVENCE ONE WAS IN SHOCK OF WHAT HAD HAPPNED, BUT SRGT. SMITH SAID THAT HE WOULD CALL ME BACK WHEN HE GOT MORE INFORMATION. AFTER WE RESUMMED, HIS DEMEANOR HAD CHANGED ENTIRELY. AFTER TALKING TO HIS WORKERS DURING OUR BREAK THAT WAS MENTIONED IN MY GRIEVENCE SMITH PERSONALLY TOLD ME THAT I WAS GIVEN EVERYTHING THAT I DENIED RECIEVING FROM THE STAFF MENTIONED IN THE INVESTIGATION SUMMARY WHICH IS JUST HEARSAY, WORD

OF MOUTH, THOUGH MY CLAIMS HAVE MERIT AND CAN BE VERIFIED BY BOTH AUDIO AND CAMERA FOOTAGE, I TOLD SRGT. SMITH THAT AS WELL AS BEFORE TALKING TO THE ABOVE.

TO WHICH WOULD HAVE ALSO SHED LIGHT ON A NEWLY PROVEN FACT THAT BACKS UP MY CLAIMS THAT MY GRIEVANCE WAS NOT THOROUGHLY INVESTIGATED EVEN THOUGH THAT IS THE DUTY AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE REVIEWER OF A GRIEVANCE/ GRIEVANCE COORDINATOR AS WELL AS MY RIGHT TO RETALIATION IS SO VIVIDLY CLEAR BY STAFFS OWN UNETHICAL WAY OF MAKING ME STAY WHEN MY CALLOUT WAS ALREADY OVER. THREATENING ME WITH MISCONDUCTS BECAUSE I WANT KNOW WHY I WAS YELLED AT, ASKING DID I DO SOMETHING WRONG. BEING MADE TO SIT IN A ROOM BY MYSELF FOR OVER 8 HOURS WITH NO FOOD OR CLEAN WATER, NOT BEING ALLOWED TO TAKE MY MEDICATION THAT IS VITAL TO MY HEALTH AND MUST TAKE EVERY SINGLE DAY, ON TIME OR THE RESULTS COULD BE FATAL FOR ME, WHICH IS WHY I AM ALLOWED TO KEEP IT INSIDE MY CELL AND NOT BEING ALLOWED TO SEND MY LEGAL MAIL TO MY ATTORNEY WHOM BY THE WAY WERE THERE INSPECTING UNITS AT THAT TIME DUE TO AN ONGOING SUIT THAT I FILED AGAINST MDOC WOMENS HURON VALLEY PRISON AND ITS OFFICIALS. I WAS NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE UNTIL MY ATTORNEYS LEFT. THIS HAPPENS TO ME ONLY WHEN MY ATTORNEYS COME FOR INSPECTIONS.

I ASK THAT THE CAMERA BE REVIEWED AND THE AUDIO BE LISTENED TO ON THIS DAY BETWEEN 8:00 am UNTIL WHEN I WAS ABLE TO LEAVE WHICH WAS A LITTLE AFTER 12 pm AND YOU WOULD SEE THAT OFFICER HENDERSON, SGT. P JOHNSON AND LT. MALLOY WERE VERY DISHONEST TO THE REVIEWER. MR. AA HORTON WAS NOT TELLING THE TRUTH AS HE ADMITS TO HOLDING ME BACK TO SPEAK WITH MY ATTORNEY THAT NEVER HAPPENED, IF IT DID PLEASE ROLL BACK THE CAMERA TO SHOW THIS CALIM I WOULD LIKE TO KNOW THE REASON OF THE ATTORNEYS AS THE HORTON CLAIMED TO NOT KNOW HOW LONG HE HAD INTENDED TO KEEP ME. WHEN I ASKED MY ATTORNEY ABOUT ANY OF THESE ALLEGATIONS HE DENIED THEM AS WELL. AA HORTON STATED THAT ONCE HE WAS AWARE THAT I HAD SPOKE WITH THE ATTORNEY AND WAS STILL AT THE CONTROL CENTER THAT HE ADVISED THE CONTROL CENTER THAT I COULD RETURN TO MY UNIT. MY QUESTION IS WHY WOULD AA HORTON BE NOTIFIED OF ME AND MY ATTORNEY VISITS AND ME STILL BEING AT CONTROL CENTER? THAT IS NOT HOW THE PROCESS WORKS NOR IS THIS DONE TO ANY OTHER PRISONER. AA HORTON SAID THAT LEGAL MAIL IS AVAILABLE TO BE SENT OUT IF THE P.C IS ON GROUNDS AND THAT THEY DONT LEAVE UNTIL 3:30pm. THIS IS ALSO NOT TRUE. ACCORDING TO POLICY, LEGAL MAIL IS TO BE DONE MON - FRI BETWEEN 8-10 am AND NO LATER. AA HORTON SAYS THAT I COULD HAVE GONE TO NEEDLINES BEFORE AND AFTER, BUT THAT IS NOT THE MEDICATION THAT I NEEDED TO TAKE. I NEEDED MY KEEP ON PERSON MEDICATIONS, WHICH ARE IN MY ROOM AT ALL TIMES. SRGT. SMITH SAYS THAT THIS WAS A COMMUNICATION CONFLICT BETWEEN MDOC AND MY ATTORNEYS AS TO HOW LONG I WAS NEEDED TO BE ACCESSED WHEN THAT TOO IS FALSE. I WAS NEVER CALLED OUT TO SPEAK TO MY ATTORNEYS. FURTHER MDOC WOULDNT ALLOW ME TO TALK TO MY ATTORNEY WITHOUT BEING ON AN ATTORNEY VISIT MY ATTORNEY AS WELL DENIES EACH CALIM TRYING TO MAKE ME SEEM TO BE ALIEN. THIS WAS EXTREMELY UNETHICAL AS WELL AS UNPROFESSIONAL. TO MAKE MATTERS WORSE, SRGT. SMITH QUOTED THE WRONG POLICY AND PROCEDURE AS HUMANE TREATMENT P.D 04.04110011000 WHICH IS THE POLICY FOR SEARCH AND ARREST. IN ADDITION TO MY INITIAL CLAIM REGARDING SRGT. SMITHS IMPROPER INVESTIGATION OF MY CLAIMS, I AM ADDING TO IT HIS IMPROPER QUOTING OF POLICY AND PROCEDURE, WHICH DID NOT APPLY TO MY SITUATION. LASTLY I DO NOT UNDERSTAND WHY MY GRIEVANCE FOR STEP ONE AND STEP TWO WERE DENIED. THERE WERE NEVER ANY JUSTIFIABLE GROUNDS REGARDING THEIR DENIAL.
