" I'm giving you a direct order to scrub the showers" or "We are taking volunteers to paint during the midnight shift" Those are the things they say. We have to hide the face that we are suffering while living with mold. In 2018 I moved to housing unit 4 where I met "Krystal Denise Clark". That's when I became close to her and slowly I watched her decline. I have witnessed the healthcare system reject her going to the hospital and just offering her a breathing treatment. Everyone thought (including nurses and doctors) that she was playing with her health but they didn't know the severity.

From my view it started with coughing. Slowly decreasing her breathing. I have pushed her to healthcare and I have watched the nurses offer her breathing treatments and they send her back to her housing unit. While she was doing her breathing treatment they would be in the healthcare hallway saying she was a "drama queen". 2019 I started noticing that she couldn't use her hands to write, so I had to help her with documents. She was swollen to the point she couldn't pick up a pen. Once again officers took her as a joke. They procrastinated with sending her to healthcare. They made her wait hours.

2020 the covid was rapid and they were tired of Krystal coming to healthcare so they put her in a observation cell. At the time I was working in that building as a prisoner observation aide and I witnessed them put Ms. Clark into a cell that was disgusting and a covid positive person had just moved out and went to the hospital.

How is that her eyes are swollen?, Her hands are swollen but MDOC healthcare says nothing is wrong? They have no results.

How can these people be so cruel? How can they play with someone's life? We all fall short. But we don't have to be killed intentionally. That's what's happening to Krystal Clark. This place is killing her. She needs real medical care. She doesn't deserve to be talked about, belittled or even told she's a "drama queen". All she wants to do is make it home to her family so she keeps fighting. Wouldn't you fight? Wouldn't you want your sister, daughter, or niece to fight?

Our healthcare prison system is corrupt. And Krystal Clark deserves to be home to receive proper medical treatment. Will you be the one to save her life? Someone has to. She deserves to hug her family. PLEASE HELP HER LIVE!!

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
