The 4,500 year old view from Mount Elizabeth “Walk and Talk” Presented by Theresa Schober

Mount Elizabeth is a prominent midden mound bordering the Indian River in Indian RiverSide Park, Jensen Beach.

On Saturday, March 23, join archaeologist Theresa Schober on a tour of the site where she highlights results of her multi-year excavations that revealed over 16 feet of earth and shell layers from human occupation dating to 4,500 years ago.

This tour and presentation will discuss the history of this fascinating site and provide details from archaeological analyses of what life was like in southeast Florida so many years ago.
