## THE OPIOID EPIDEMIC



## BY THE NUMBERS

More than one million people have died from overdoses in the past two decades.

In 2019, 137 people died every day in the United States from opioid overdose.

Approximately 275 people died a day from anoverdose related death in 2021.

Over 100,000 people died of overdose deaths in 2020 - an increase of 31% compared to the year before.

During the pandemic, more than 40 states have reported increases in opioid-related mortality.

Since the first reported case of COVID-19, overdose deaths increased over 20%.

There were 13,193 narcan deployments in New Jersey in 2020.

Between 21% and 29% of patients prescribed opioids for chronic pain misuse them.

4 out of 5 people who use heroin misused a prescription opioid first.

The rate of **cocaine use has almost tripled in the past five years a**nd psychostimulants have increased almost four times.
