Rules of Play for 50/50 Electronic Raffle:

1. The lottery will take place monthly online during July 1, 2020 and end on June 30, 2021.

The series of draws are as follows:

(July 1, 2020 at 9:00am – July 30th at 11:55pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on July 31st at 11am)
2. Draw #2 August 1 – August 31, 2020
(August 1, 2020 at 9am – August 30th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on August 31st at 11am)
3. Draw #3 September 1 – September 30, 2020
(September 1, 2020 at 9am – September 29th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on September 30th at 11am)
4. Draw #4 October 1 – October 31, 2020
(October 1, 2020 at 9am – October 30th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on October 31st at 11am)
5. Draw #5 November 1 – November 30, 2020
(November 1, 2020 at 9am – November 29th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on November 30th at 11am)
6. Draw #6 December 1 – December 31, 2020
(December 1, 2020 at 9am – December 30th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on December 31st at 11am)
7. Draw #7 January 1 – January 30, 2021
(January 1, 2021 at 9am – January 30th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on January 31st at 11am)
8. Draw #8 February 1 – February 28, 2021
(February 1, 2021 at 9am – February 27th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on February 28th at 11am)
9. Draw #9 March 1 – March 31, 2021
(March 1, 2021 at 9am – March 30th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on March 31st at 11am)
10. Draw #10 April 1 – April 30, 2021
(April 1, 2021 at 9am – April 29th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on April 30th at 11am)

11. Draw #11 May 1 – May 31, 2021
(May 1, 2021 at 9am – May 30th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on May 31st at 11am)
12. Draw # 12 June 1 – June 30, 2021
(June 1, 2021 at 9am – June 29th at 11:55 pm, with the draw and winner announcement taking place on June 30th at 11am)

2. All tickets will only be sold to people who are 18 years of age or older.
3. Must be in Ontario at the time of purchase.
4. Tickets are 3 for \$5.00, 10 for \$10.00 and 60 for \$20.00.
5. Tickets will be available online at www.Epilepsy5050.ca
6. Tickets will be sold using electronic raffle system supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
7. After buying, patrons will be given by the sellers, a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
8. The winning ticket number will be selected by a Random Number Generation (RNG) system from all raffle numbers sold for the draw.
9. The amount of the 50/50 will be determine based on number of tickets sold
10. The winning number will be announced online at www.Epilepsy5050.ca
11. The winner may claim their prize by contacting *Epilepsy Ontario* at: (905) 738-9431, or by email at: specialprojects@epilepsyontario.org. The ticket may then be brought 470 North Rivermede Rd., Unit 15, Concord, On at an agreed upon time for ticket verification. The winner will then be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event for which they bought their ticket. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies. **All payments will be made by cheque.**
12. The winning ticket holder has **6 months** in which to claim their prize from the date of the draw their ticket was purchased for.
13. The winner must provide his/her name, address, and phone number with picture identification for our report sheet.
14. Once the certified winner is verified, and provides identification with photo ID, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that draw. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
15. In the event that no winner comes forward, the winning stub will kept in a safety deposit box and held for 6 months. After that time period has elapsed the prize will be donated to a charity other than Epilepsy Ontario, with the approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).
