



GCFP FLOWER SHOW STATE AWARDS

Presented at Standard Flower Show Only

Apply to the state using the GCFP APPLICATION FOR NATIONAL AND STATE FLOWER SHOW AWARD RIBBONS with the State Ribbons Chairperson. Cards or rosettes may be ordered.

A. **Education and/or Conservation Silver Award** – Solver Ribbon

This award may be given to an educational exhibit of exceptional quality, clearly labeled and informative. This exhibit need not score 95 points. An education and/or conservation exhibit cannot receive both the National Garden Clubs and GCFP State Award concurrently. The award must be listed in the show schedule and requested on the awards application form. Only one ribbon may be award in a show. Use NGC Educational Exhibits Scale of Points.

B. **Junior Flower Show Award** – Orange Ribbon

This award may be given for an all Junior Standard Flower Show held independently or in the same building as a senior show. The award will be given to the sponsoring Senior Garden Club at the time of the show. The show must be of unusual merit. Winners of this award are eligible to apply for the NGC Flower Show Achievement award (FS-17C) Youth Flower Show and/or the GCFP Flower Show Achievement Award. The award must be listed in the awards list in the show schedule and requested on the awards application.

C. **Special Recognition Award** – Yellow and Blue Ribbon

This award may be given to an exhibit scoring 95 points or more in any artistic design class if it is not listed as eligible to receive a top National award. There may be only one Special Recognition Award given in a show. The award must be listed in the Awards list in the show schedule and requested on the awards application. Use Design Scale of Points.

D. **Flower Show Staging Award** – Gold Ribbon

This award may be given to the club or clubs scoring 90 or above on the following SCORING RUBRIC: (** Revised and accepted at Judges Council Annual Meeting April 28, 2003)

A. Staging carries out the theme of the show in an artistic and creative manner	15
B. Floor plan presents a good traffic pattern with adequate unobstructed aisles and has a well-balanced appearance	15
C. Entrance is inviting and easily identified	10
D Lighting is sufficient for the area	10
E. Exhibits in the horticulture section are uncrowded and in appropriately sized containers.	10
F. Entries in the design division are well-spaced and easily viewed	10
G. Signage is attractive, legible and appropriate in size	10
H. Over-all show presented a high standard of excellence, which includes Beauty, Harmony, Expression and Distinction.....	20
