FD-2 FLORAL DESIGN PROGRAM: 1. GARDEN CLUB FALL CENTERPIECE WORKSHOP

The Hands-On Fall Centerpiece Workshop was presented/demonstrated:

Gwen, an accomplished floral designer, has been a WWGC member since 2000 and has won several first-place awards at the Philadelphia Flower Show.

ACHIEVEMENT

Using a 12" Oasis ring, participants created a fall wreath using assorted fresh mums, hydrangeas, and greens. Gwen demonstrated a pave-style arrangement.

Members who signed up for and participated in this workshop created a beautiful arrangement using their own interpretation of the design demonstrated. They took their projects home to finish with décor that they had around their house.

Research and Preparation:

- Purchased flowers and prepared a sample arrangement to be shown at the October meeting to encourage members to attend.
- Purchased Oasis rings from Amazon.
- Purchased assorted fresh cut mums the day before from Trader Joe's. Gave them a fresh cut and conditioned them.
- Cut greens and hydrangeas from Gwen's garden the day before and conditioned them.
- Prepared workspace in the house for the workshop.
- Taped and soaked the oasis rings prior to participants arrivals.

Materials Used:

12" Oasis ring, assorted cut mums, limelight hydrangeas and Ilex greens.

Workshop Day: Participants arrived at Gwen's house at 7 p.m. Gwen began the evening giving a short demonstration how to design a pave-style arrangement. Once the participants completed their wreaths, Gwen showed different ways to finish the project once they got home using items they might have around the house, such as pumpkins or candles. By offering for sale extra rings, Gwen also discussed how they could make this centerpiece into a Christmas arrangement and highlight different floral materials as well as décor to finish the project. At the end of the evening Gwen gave tips on how to properly care for your arrangement and extend its life. By following Gwen's suggestion, the arrangement should last 2 weeks. Once home all the participants sent in pictures to the group on how they finished the project at home.

PARTICIPATION

The workshop was a near break-even venture with 11 members paying \$25 to participate in the workshop. The club membership is 41 including non-active honorary members. Participation was approx. 26%.
