- Brief descriptions and a photo of each garden due October 30, 2025
- Appoint a Club Garden Tour District Liaison to report to the PA Garden Party Chair
- Appoint a Sponsorship/Ad Chair to assemble a committee to solicit ads for the tour booklet from local businesses, garden centers, etc.
- Two hosts needed at each garden at all times
- Sell tickets to general public, as well as gardeners and plant societies, through PA Garden Party Registrar

GCFP will provide the tour booklets, directional signs, posters,  
handle ticket sales and registration.

Tour booklet will contain:

- Small photo and description of each garden by district/area
- Sponsorships, ads, info about GCFP, and joining a garden club
