COVID-19 Policies & Procedures

When scheduling and/or confirming patients, ask patients to stay home and contact their primary care physician if they have a respiratory illness, fever, or if they have traveled outside of the country in the past 14 days. They may reschedule once they are released from their physician.

Patients are still required to check in at the front iPads. However, we will practice social distancing outside the treatment rooms, sanitizing thoroughly, and minimizing personal contact in the office. Patient appointments will be spaced appropriately to avoid more than three people in the waiting room at one time. Reception chairs are separated, and all magazines are removed.

iPads, adjustment tables, roller beds, computers and any surface that the patient or DC encounters in the office are to be sanitized after each patient. All staff are expected to use sanitizer or wash hands as noted in restrooms after contact with each patient.

Employees who present with any flu-like symptoms will be asked to remain home until there is no threat of infection.

- Patients waiting must keep at least 6 feet apart.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds according to instructions posted.
- Place hand sanitizers in multiple locations.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home if you are sick.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze.
- Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces with Thieves cleaner. This includes tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks.
- Provide tissues and disposable wipes for no-touch receptacles.
- Thieves is diffused and used as cleaner on all surfaces. It kills 99.9% bacteria, viruses and molds.
- No handshaking or unnecessary physical contact.
