Unless one has become completely destitute, there are almost always options for making it work. Moving, having children, acquiring a second job, etc., are rarely good excuses. Only 1 in 600 hundred pit bulls find homes as the majority of shelters do not adopt them out. Our job in making great placements has become increasingly difficult as the economy is declining. Adopting a pit bull makes room for us to save another deathrow dog. When people break that commitment and we have to take a dog back into our program, another dog loses his/her life at the shelter, as well as a great deal of stress on the dog being returned. Thoughtful planning for the LIFE of one's dog in truly a matter of life and death.
