1. Information We Collect

What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device (computer, tablet, smartphone) when you visit a website. They help websites recognize your device, remember user preferences, and understand how visitors interact with content.

Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following categories of cookies on our website:

• Strictly Necessary Cookies

These are essential for the website to function properly (e.g., page navigation, access to secure areas). These cookies cannot be disabled.

Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use the site, such as which pages are visited most often. We use tools such as Google Analytics for this purpose. These cookies help us improve the functionality and content of our website.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies remember choices you make (like language preferences) to provide a more personalized experience.

Marketing and Third-Party Cookies

These cookies may be set through embedded content (e.g., YouTube videos, social media widgets) or by services like Facebook Pixel. They may track browsing activity across websites and help deliver relevant ads or content.

We may use third-party services that place cookies on your device. These services include but may not be limited to:

How to Manage or Withdraw Cookie Consent

When you first visit our site, you may be presented with a cookie banner asking for your consent to use non-essential cookies. You may:

- Customize Preferences to choose which categories you allow

You may also change your cookie settings at any time by revisiting the banner or clearing your cookies.

Retention of Cookie Data

Cookie retention varies by type:

- Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies remain on your device for a set period (e.g., 30 days to 2 years), unless deleted manually.

5. Your Rights
