- Regular Cleaning - Increased cleaning measures throughout the club for areas & equipment

Delivery of activities

- Clean surfaces, resources/equipment after use
- We have adapted our games and activities to increase distancing as much as possible but also ensuring children can still have as much fun, as well as reducing the need to share equipment.
- Children will take part in activities within the same group for the duration of the club using as much space as possible
- Limiting Group Size – group sizes will be up to 10 children allowing for space within our indoor hall
