I understand this night was regarding the harlot, but there are appropriate & modest ways to portray that. As followers of Christ, we are expected to not cause our brothers to stumble and the pictures of immodest women shown were inappropriate to be showing to God's people. Please be careful and think through even these "small" things (that can't become big things for others) because they are important to God as well. Please take this message out of love and guidance and do not feel attacked. Thank you for your consideration.

I genuinely appreciate your heart for modesty, holiness, and honoring God in all aspects of our ministry—including visuals. I agree that we are called to be mindful not only of what we say but also of what we show, and your reminder is well taken.
